2016 WESTERN TRI SERIES – TOURNAMENT CONDITIONS

(To be read in conjunction with the Golf Victoria Standard Event Conditions as published on the GV Website at www.golfvic.org.au)

1. COMPETITION PROCEDURES

- 1.1 The Championship is scheduled to be played over 54 holes Stroke play, 18 holes each round.
- 1.2 The field for the Championship will be limited to 120 players with entries accepted on an as received basis.
- 1.3 The players with the lowest male and female stroke score after 54 holes shall be the Western Tri Series Boys and Girls Champions respectively.
- 1.4 The players with the lowest male and female nett score after 54 holes shall be the Western Tri Series Boys and Girls Handicap Champions respectively.
- 1.5 In the event of a tie for the leading position in the stroke section after 54-holes, a sudden-death play-off will decide the winner. Ties for all other positions shall be decided by count-back as recommended by Golf Australia.

2. ELIGIBILITY:

- 2.1 Eligible players are male and female amateurs who are under 18 years of age as at the 21 of January, 2016 and whose GA Handicap does not exceed 36 for males and 45 for females.
- 2.2 Entries will be restricted to amateurs, who are members of clubs affiliated with Golf Victoria, or of golf clubs registered with such State or Overseas Associations as are affiliated with or recognised by this Association, or of clubs affiliated with the Victorian Golf League and Registered Golfers.

3. ENTRIES:

3.1 54 Hole Western Tri Series Junior Classic: The entry fee is \$76 for Non-Host Club Members and \$56 for Host Club Members. Entry fee must be paid at the time of entry.

Individual 18 Hole Events: The entry fee is \$27.50 for Non-Host Club Members and \$20 for Host Club Members. Entry fee must be paid at the time of entry.

- 3.2 The championship Committee shall have the right to refuse the entry of any person without being required to give any reason for such refusal.
- **3.3** Entries shall only be made on the official entry form.
- 3.4 The draw for the competition will be sent to players and available on the host club websites and Golf Victoria website approximately one week before the event.

4. EXEMPTIONS:

The Championship Committee will grant 10 exemptions to juniors from each of the host clubs. Those exemptions will be decided by the host clubs.

5. REFUND POLICY:

Any entrant may withdraw and have their entry fee refunded providing notification is received before the draw is completed. Under no circumstances will entry fees be refunded after this date unless players can provide the Championship Committee with supporting documents regarding their withdrawal from the event (ie. Medical Certificate).

6. RULES:

The competition shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as adopted by R&A Rules Limited, together with such local rules as are in force on the course over which the competition rounds are being played. If any dispute arises on any point, it shall be decided by the Championship Committee whose decision shall be final. All players are required to adhere to Golf Victoria's Code of Conduct for the duration of the competition.

8. TROPHIES:

In addition to the 54 Hole Overall Championship. Prizes will be awarded for:

- Western Tri Series Under 16 Boys Champion Lowest Stroke Score returned by a player aged 14 or 15. The runner-up shall also receive a prize.
- Western Tri Series Under 14 Boys Champion Lowest Stroke Score returned by a player aged 13 or under. The runner-up shall also receive a prize.
- Western Tri Series Under 14 Girls Champion Lowest Stroke Score returned by a player aged 13 or under. The runner-up shall also receive a prize.
- Western Tri Series Under 16 Boys Handicap Champion – Lowest Nett Score returned by a player aged 14 or 15. The runner-up shall also receive a trophy.
- Western Tri Series Under 14 Boys Handicap Champion – Lowest Nett Score returned by a player aged 13 or under. The runner-up shall also receive a trophy.
- Western Tri Series Under 14 Girls Handicap Champion – Lowest Nett Score returned by a player aged 13 or under. The runner-up shall also receive a trophy.
- *Age group prizes will only be awarded if minimum numbers are reached in each category

Daily Events:

Prizes will be awarded on a daily basis also with a presentation to be held at the conclusion of each round. Prizes will be awarded for Best Gross score and Runner Up as well as Best Nett Score and Runner Up.

9. HONORARY MEMBERS:

Competitors will be made Honorary Members for the day, of the club upon whose course the rounds are being played.

10. PRACTICE ROUNDS

Competitors only should contact the golf clubs directly to check on the availability of any practice rounds.

11. PULL BUGGIES

There will be limited pull buggies available at each of the host clubs. Players who have a buggy should bring their own where possible.

12. CHAMPIONSHIP COMMITTEE:

The Championship shall consist of representatives of the all three Host Golf Clubs.

The Championship Committee reserves the right to vary any conditions of this event due to unforeseen circumstances, including draw and starting times.

Protests must be made to the Championship Committee not later than 10 minutes after the conclusion of each round. The decision of the Championship Committee will be final in all matters relating to the Tournament.
