2016 CRANBOURNE SENIOR AMATEUR – TOURNAMENT CONDITIONS

(To be read in conjunction with the Golf Victoria Standard Event Conditions as published on the GV Website at www.golfvic.org.au)

1. COMPETITION PROCEDURES

- **1.1** The Championship is scheduled to be played over 36 holes Stroke play, 18 holes each day.
- **1.2** The field for the Championship will be limited to 112 players with entries accepted on an as received basis.
- **1.3** The player with the lowest stroke score after 36 holes shall be the Cranbourne Senior Amateur Champion.
- **1.4** The player with the lowest nett score after 36 holes shall be the Cranbourne Senior Amateur Handicap Champion.
- **1.5** In the event of a tie for the leading position in the stroke section after 36-holes, a sudden-death play-off is to be staged if time permits, otherwise a count-back will be utilised. Ties for all other positions shall be decided by count-back as recommended by Golf Australia.

2. ELIGIBILITY

- **2.1** Eligible players are male amateurs who have reached their 55th birthday by Monday 29 February 2016 and whose Golf Australia Handicap at the time of entry does not exceed 24.4 strokes in accordance with the Australian Handicapping System.
- 2.2 Entries will be restricted to amateurs, who are members of clubs affiliated with Golf Victoria, or of golf clubs registered with such State or Overseas Associations as are affiliated with or recognised by this Association, or of clubs affiliated with the Victorian Golf League and Registered Golfers.
- **2.3** A male player is required to play from their current GA Handicap with the exception that no player shall play from a Daily Handicap greater than 24 strokes. **Exception:** Players subject to the provisions of Condition 2.4.
- 2.4 In accordance with Section 17 of the GA Handicap System, the leading 30 players from the 2015 Paul Lulofs Trophy and any player within the leading 30 players of the 2016 Paul Lulofs Trophy as at March 31; June 30 and/or September 30 will be allocated a Special Competition GA Handicap.

Each player's Special Competition GA Handicap will be calculated on the basis of scores returned in Victorian Senior Order of Merit events only, in accordance with the regular calculation provisions of the GA Handicap System and updated following each Victorian Senior Order of Merit event.

For each 2016 Victorian Senior Order of Merit event, players subject to this condition are required to play from the lower of either their Special Competition GA Handicap or their current GA Handicap with the exception that no player shall play from a Daily Handicap greater than 24 strokes.

3. ENTRIES

- **3.1** The entry fee is \$100.00 for non-members of Cranbourne GC and \$50.00 for Cranbourne members. Entry fee must be paid at the time of entry and includes GST & \$2 charity donation.
- **3.2** Golf Victoria shall have the right to refuse the entry of any person without being required to give any reason for such refusal.
- **3.3** Entries shall only be made on the official entry form or online at <u>www.golfvic.org.au</u>.
- **3.5** The draw for the competition will be sent to players and available at <u>www.golfvic.org.au</u> approximately one week before the event.

4. TROPHIES

Trophies will be awarded for: No player may win more than one trophy.

Order of Merit Events:

- <u>36 Hole Gross</u> Cranbourne Senior Amateur Champion and Runner-up
- <u>36 Hole Nett</u> Cranbourne Senior Amateur Handicap Champion and Runner-up

Other:

- Best 36-Hole Stroke (Age 65 and over)
- Best 36-Hole Nett (Hcp 10 and over)
- 36-Hole Nett ball run-down

5. CHAMPIONSHIP COMMITTEE

The Committee shall consist of Golf Victoria representatives and the Match Committee of the Club upon whose course the rounds are being played. In the absence of a full Championship Committee, such members thereof, as may be present at the time, may give a decision so given shall be deemed to be a decision of the full Championship Committee. In the event of bad weather, or for any other reason, the Championship Committee may shorten the competition, appoint another day or days for completion of, or may transfer play to another course. Protests must be made to the Championship Committee not later than 10 minutes after the conclusion of each round.

6. REFUND POLICY

Any entrant may withdraw and have their entry fee refunded providing notification is received within **three working days** prior to the commencement of the event. Under no circumstances will entry fees be refunded after this date unless players can provide Golf Victoria supporting documents regarding their withdrawal from the event (i.e. Medical Certificate).

7. MOTORISED TRANSPORT

According to GV's standard conditions of competitions, it is the responsibility of the player, if they require the use of a golf cart during the event to send a Medical Certificate and a completed copy of the Golf Victoria Motorised Transport Approval Return Form for consideration by the Match Committee. Please go to the GV website under Rules & Handicapping \rightarrow GV Motorised Transport for the return form and more information.

Exemption: Players aged 75 years and over do not require a Medical Certificate. Golf carts are at the player's own expense and MUST be booked directly with the respective golf club as soon as possible. Golf Victoria cannot guarantee the use of a golf cart on any given day of play as this is subject to each host club's conditions of usage.

Note: In the event in which a limited number of carts are available, players requesting carts will be paired together. Caddies are permitted to ride in the cart with the player ONLY when sufficient carts are available.

8. PRACTICE

The course will be available to participants for practice at a reduced green fee of \$30.00 on Thursday 25 February 2016 (PM only), and Friday 26 February 2016 (PM only). Prior arrangements for practice rounds MUST be made with the host club by contacting the Pro Shop on (03) 5991 3456.
