### 2016 Lindisfarne Cup Golf Tournament Championship Conditions

#### The Match and Rules Committee of the TGC (MRC) are the controlling body for this event.

#### 1. The Championship

- 1.1 The Event is open to male amateur golfers, either amateur or professional. Amateur players must have a current Golf Australia handicap of 18.4 or less which has been certified by his home Club Secretary. Professional players must be members of the Professional Golfers Association of Australia.
- 1.2 The Lindisfarne Cup Golf Tournament will be played over 36 holes on Saturday 6<sup>th</sup> and Sunday 7<sup>th</sup> of February 2016. In the case of inclement weather and / or unplayable conditions, the event may be reduced to 18 holes.
- 1.3 The field will be limited to 80 players.

#### 2. Entries

- 2.1 All entrants must stipulate their date of birth on the entry form.
- 2.2 Entries must be made on the attached form and must be accompanied by the entry fee. They must be in the hands of the Competitions Manager, Tasmania Golf Club, PO Box 425, SORELL, 7172 no later than 5.00pm on the Monday 1st of February 2016.
- 2.3 Late entries may be accepted but this will be at the discretion of the Club Captain.
- 2.4 In the event of applications exceeding the number of places available, entries for higher handicap competitors will be decided by handicap ballot. Unsuccessful entrants will be informed without delay and given the opportunity to compete if withdrawals subsequently occur. Entrance fees will be refunded to entrants balloted out, who do not compete.

#### 3. Membership Privileges

All competitors will be made honorary members, without fee, courtesy of the Host Club, on the respective days of play.

#### Rules

- 4.1 Rules of Golf as adopted by R&A Rules Limited will apply together with such Local Rules as are approved by the MRC.
- 4.2 The decision of the MRC will be final in all matters relating to the event. Protests must be made in writing to the MRC not later than 15 minutes after the conclusion of the day's play.
- 4.3 The MRC reserves the right to vary any condition of this event and to refuse any entry without explanation.

#### 5. Handicans

- 5.1 All Handicaps will be fixed by the MRC and they reserve the right to make any alteration to the Handicap of any entrant before he starts in each Event should it deem desirable.
- 5.2 The Handicap used in this Competition shall be the players **Daily Handicap** as registered at the commencement for the first round and will remain for the entirety of the event.
- 5.3 It is the duty of each competitor to report any reduction in his handicap to the starter prior to commencing his first round.

#### 6. Time of Starting

Should a competitor miss their start tee time, it is at the discretion of the Starter as to whether another start tee time is allocated for that round. The MRC will make a separate decision with regard to that competitor's eligibility for the Tournament.

#### 7. Pace of Play

Rule 6-7 will be strictly enforced. Each group must maintain its position on the course with respect to the group preceding it. Any group with a clear hole in front of it will be considered out of position. Penalties will be issued to individuals in such groups who by their pace contribute to such delays .Warnings may not be issued prior to any penalty. A penalty issued shall be at the sole discretion of the MRC.

#### 8. Ties

- 8.1 In the event of a tie or ties for the Championship, unless the Committee otherwise determines, play shall continue immediately upon completion of the final round of the Championship over holes 7, 8 and 9 with the lowest cumulative gross score to determine the winner. If scores remain tied, play shall continue over the same holes with players being eliminated hole by hole as they fail to maintain equality with other or others until the winner is determined (sudden death).
- 8.2 Ties in handicap events will be decided by count back in accordance with the system approved by Golf Australia.

#### 9. GPS Measuring Devices

A player may obtain distance information using a device that measures distance only. If during a stipulated round, a player uses a distance measuring device that is designed to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect his play (e.g. gradient, wind-speed, temperature, etc), the player is in breach of Rule 14-3.

#### 10. Motorised Transport

During play, it is prohibited for a player or their caddy to ride in or on a motorised vehicle unless permitted in writing by the MRC prior to the commencement of the round.

Stroke-play - Two strokes for each hole at which a breach occurred; maximum penalty per round - Four strokes.

Note: Permission will only be granted for medical reasons.

#### 11. Inclement Weather / Unplayable Conditions

- 11.1 In the event of inclement weather and / or unplayable conditions, the MRC may order a temporary suspension or permanent cessation of play.
- 11.2 In the event of a round being abandoned the MRC, at its sole and absolute discretion, the event will revert to a 18 hole championship.

#### 12. Code of Conduct

- 12.1 All entrants agree to be bound by Golf Australia's Code of Conduct. A copy of the code is available at <a href="www.golfaustralia.org.au">www.golfaustralia.org.au</a> In addition all members agree to be bound by the standards of conduct expected of members of Tasmania Golf Club and, in the event those standards are breached, acknowledge that they will be subject to sanctions imposed by the MRC..
- 12.2 If a competitor fails to report for any round, fails to meet all his playing obligations and fails to submit a satisfactory reason to the MRC, future entries may be refused for tournaments held at the Host Club.
- 12.3 In the event of a player failing to hand in a card and satisfactorily explaining the omission to the MRC, he will be disqualified from all events in the Tournament.

#### 13. Local Rules

13.1 Other Local Rules will be posted as required.

#### CHAMPIONSHIP PROGRAMME

#### **EVENT NO. 1 - 2016 LINDISFARNE CUP GOLF TOURNAMENT**

36 Holes Stroke Play.

#### **EVENT NO. 2 - JUNIOR 36 HOLE SCRATCH**

Concurrent with event number 1. Open to all amateur players who are aged under 18 years as at the last day of the competition. Entrants must state their date of birth on the entry form.

#### **EVENT NO. 3 - COLTS 36 HOLE SCRATCH**

Concurrent with event number 1. Open to all amateur players who are aged 18 years to 23 years inclusive as at the last day of the competition. Entrants must state their date of birth on the entry form.

#### **EVENT NO. 4 - SENIOR 36 HOLE SCRATCH**

Concurrent with event number 1. Open to all amateur players who are 55 years of age and over, as at the last day of the competition. Entrants must state their date of birth on the entry form.

**EVENT NO. 5 - JUNIOR 36 HOLE NETT** 

**EVENT NO. 6- COLTS 36 HOLE NETT** 

**EVENT NO. 7 - SENIOR 36 HOLE NETT** 

**NOTE:** Eligibility for events 5, 6 and 7 as per relevant 'scratch' events.

Junior, Colts and Senior events must have a minimum of six (6) players in each.
