## **CONDITIONS OF PLAY**

### **MONA VALE WOMEN'S SENIOR ORDER OF MERIT**

*18 HOLE STROKE EVENT with trophies for Winner, Runner-up and Nett*

#### **GA handicap limit 29.4**

*Participants must be female golfers with a current GA handicap, who are members of an affiliated club and who have attained the age of 55 years. Play is to be strictly to the Rules of Golf (Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews), Local Rules and By-laws of the club. Any and all decisions pertaining to questionable situations will be made by the Match Committee and will be governed by the above Rules of Golf.*

*It is the players' responsibility to enter their daily handicap onto their score card, using their current GA handicap and the Daily Handicap Lookup Chart supplied.*

*Motorised transport is not permitted unless a medical certificate is provided. Use of mobile phones is not permitted on the course. Players may have a caddie. Players may obtain distance information by using a device that measures distance only.*

*In the event of ties the best score for the last 9 holes shall be used, if then still a tie the last 6 holes, or if still tied the last three. If a tie still persists then hole by hole back from the 18<sup>th</sup> hole. Countback for nett results determined applying the stroke index of those holes.*

*Lodging of Objections : In all competitions under GA conditions, objections shall be made to the committee responsible for the competition. The match Committee reserves the right to vary the Conditions of Play to deal with unforeseen circumstances.*

*Competition will be played if the course is not closed. Practice is not permitted on the course prior to hit off time on the day.*
