SOUTH GIPPSLAND JUNIOR GOLF CLASSIC CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. The competition shall be played over 36 holes stroke play for 'A' Grade and 27 holes stroke for 'B' & 'C' Grade on Friday 8th April 2016. The field shall be limited to 90 players. Should a ballot be necessary, the Match Committee shall decide whose entry shall be accepted.
2. Entries, accompanied by the entrance fee of \$30.00 will only be accepted on the official entry form.
3. Entries are restricted to amateurs who are under 18 years of age on the day of the event, and who are members of Clubs of the Association, or of Clubs registered with such State or overseas Association as are affiliated with, or recognized by this Association, or of Clubs affiliated with the Victorian Golf League, and registered golfers, and the Committee shall have the right to refuse the entry of any person without being required to give a reason for such refusal.
4. All entrants must have a current Australian handicap administered by GolfLink. The maximum handicap for boys shall be 36, and for females 45.
5. Grades shall be as follows: 'A' Grade 0-9; 'B' Grade 10 - 18; 'C' Grade 19+
6. Ties in scratch events shall be decided by playoff, over holes decided by the Match Committee, or as otherwise decided by the Match Committee. Ties in handicap events shall be decided by count back using the approved method as adopted by the Golf Australia.
7. The competition shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf, as adopted by the Royal & Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews, Scotland, together with such local rules as are in force on the competition course.
8. Should a dispute arises on any point, it shall be decided by the Match Committee in charge of the competition, whose decision shall be final. Provided however, that the Committee if in doubt shall have the right to refer any such dispute to Golf Victoria.
9. The Match Committee may in the event of bad weather, or for any other reason, either shorten an event, or suspend play.
10. The Match Committee will decide grade limits following the close of entries.
11. Protests must be lodged, in writing, not more than 30 minutes after the completion of play.
12. The Match Committee shall have the right to temporarily alter a player's handicap, in accordance with the U.S.G.A. handicapping system.
13. The use of motorized (ride on) buggies by players is prohibited.
14. Professional Golfers will NOT be permitted to act as caddies during the event.
15. Players will be required to report to the starter at least (10) ten minutes prior to their tee time
16. Entries close at 5.00pm on Thursday 2nd April 2015. Post entries will only be accepted if the field limit is not reached.
17. Competitors shall be limited to (1) one trophy, excluding 36 & 27 holes events & nearest the pin events.

NOTE: Entrants who have registered for the Geoff Ogilvy Trophy who hold a handicap over the maximum 'A' Grade handicap limit will play the 36 holes stroke event. Please indicate if you are a 'Geoff Ogilvy Trophy' entrant
