Golf Australia has given to Golf Tasmania a silver bowl for annual competition, to be known as the International Bowl. Entry fees from these events are used by Golf Australia to finance Australian international golf.

CONDITIONS

A period shall be allocated to each affiliated club by Golf Tasmania, during which time clubs may hold 18-hole stroke competitions on one, two or three days, preferably early in the period to allow for postponement.

A single entry fee (to be decided by Golf Australia) entitles a competitor to return up to three cards in this competition, and a member of more than one club may compete at any club of which she is a member for an additional entry fee at each club.

Any club may give permission to visiting players (other than a member of that club) to take part in that club's competition, and may also arrange a competition for business girls who have not already taken part in the club's competition.

The player in each division with the lowest nett score in relation to the AWCR will be the winner. Golf Australia handicaps are to be used. If a player enters in one division and then reduces or increases to another division, she may compete in both by paying an additional entry fee, thereby becoming eligible to win in both divisions.

The winning card, or cards, in each club should be sent to the General Manager of Golf Tasmania. In the event of a tie at club level (on the same day and in the same division), normal count back method for 18-hole nett events will be used.

In the event of a tie between different clubs (in the same division); the following method will be used:

Player A Course a. AWCR = 73

Scratch score minus handicap: 93-29=64 nett - 9 under

Player B Course b. AWCR = 75

Scratch score minus handicap: 91-25=66 nett - 9 under

As both players have achieved 9 under in relation to the AWCR the normal count back method will be utilised, i.e. ½ handicap for the last 9 holes etc.

The cup is to be held by the winner's club in each division equally.
