Conditions

1. Format

- 1.1 Played over 18 holes of stroke play
- 1.2 In the event of a tie for first place, unless the Match Committee determines otherwise, players in such a tie will continue play over such holes as the Match Committee will decide, in a sudden-death, hole-byhole playoff until the winner is determined. Ties for other place getters will be decided by countback.

2. Handicaps

2.1 Registration GA handicap.

Boys: 27.0 maximum at time of entry Girls: 36.0 maximum at time of entry

3. Match Committee

- 3.1 The Match Committee will comprise the Golf SA Match Committee.
- 3.2 In the absence of the full Match Committee, such members as may be present at the time, may give a decision, and any decision so given will be deemed to be a decision of the full Match Committee.
- 3.3 The Match Committee will have the sole management and control of the event, with full power at any time to alter or vary any one of the Conditions.
- 3.4 The Match Committee's decision on matters affecting the event will be final.
- 3.5 Any dispute or protest must be made to the Match Committee not more than 15 minutes after the conclusion of play on the day on which the disputed matter has arisen.

4. Rules of Play

4.1 The Rules of Golf, as adopted by R & A Rules Limited, will apply together with Local Rules of the venue Club.

5. Entries

- 5.1 Eligible players for the event are Junior Boy and Girl Amateur Golfers who are members of Golf Clubs affiliated with GOLF SA who satisfy the necessary handicap and age qualifications.
- 5.2 The Entrance Fee for the event is \$35.00 (including GST and lunch), and must be paid at the time of entry.
- 5.3 Entries must be made via the Golf SA online registration system. Entries by any other method will not be accepted.
- 5.4 The decision of the Match Committee as to acceptance or refusal of any entry will be final.
- 5.5 Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Match Committee.
- 5.6 Players must register by 5:00pm on Wednesday 13th
 April 2016. IT IS THE SOLE RESPONSIBILITY OF
 THE ENTRANT THEMSELVES TO ENSURE THAT
 THEY HAVE REGISTERED CORRECTLY. A player
 has not officially registered until their name is listed in
 the Registered Participants section of the event
 registration page.

6. Conforming Golf Balls & Conforming Driver Heads

6.1 The specimen conditions in the Rules of Golf are in effect as regards to Conforming Golf Balls and Conforming Driver Heads.

7. Drug Testing

7.1 All competitors are subject to drug testing by the Australian Sports Anti-Doping Agency for banned substances as laid down in Golf Australia's Anti-Doping Policy. Any competitor infringing this policy, or refusing to take a test, will be disqualified and subject to any sanction(s) brought down by ASADA.

8. Smoking

8.1 Players and caddies are prohibited from smoking cigarettes, cigars or the like during a stipulated round. See Golf SA's Code of Conduct.

9. Mobile Phones

9.1 Except in case of emergency, mobile phones must not be used to make or receive calls or messages when on the golf course.

10. Pace of Play

10.1 Rule 6-7 will be strictly enforced. Each group must maintain its position on the course with respect to the group preceding it. Any group with a clear hole in front of it will be considered to be out of position. Penalties will be issued to individuals in such groups who by their pace contribute to such delay. Warnings may not be issued prior to penalties.

11. Motorised Transport

11.1 Ride-on buggies will be permitted only on medical evidence from the player's Club and by permission of the venue Club. Applications and approvals to be forwarded to Golf SA at time of registration. Caddies are not permitted to use ride-on buggies.

12. Code of Conduct

12.1 All entrants assent to be bound by Golf SA's Code of Conduct. A copy of the Code is available at www.golfsa.com.au.

13. Measuring Devices

13.1 A player may obtain distance information by use of a distance-measuring device. If, during a stipulated round, a player uses a distance-measuring device to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect their play (e.g. elevation changes, wind speed etc.), the player is in breach of Rule 14-3.

14. Draws

14.1 Tee times will be available on the Golf SA website www.golfsa.com.au from Friday 15th April 2016.

- Dress Rules Players must comply with the host Clubs dress code.
