CONDITIONS

1 FORMAT

1.1 The Championship is a Men's & Women's tournament played over 54 holes - stroke play at Alice Springs Golf Club (ASGC). **Round 1** Saturday 26th March, **Round 2** Sunday 27th March, **Round 3** Monday 28th March

1.2 Rounds 1 and 2 of the Championship will not be seeded. Players can expect one morning and one afternoon tee time.

1.3 A fully seeded draw within grades will be conducted for Rounds 3 of the Championship.

1.4 The winning player shall be the Alice Springs Open Champion.

1.5 In the event of a tie for any major event, which includes gross events for all grades, there will be a sudden-death play-off commencing on the 18th hole until a winner is determined.

2. CHAMPIONSHIP COMMITTEE

2.1 The Championship Committee for the event will be the Alice Springs Golf Club Captain and Match Committee.

2.2 The Championship Committee's decisions on matters affecting the Championship shall be final. Protests must be made in writing and submitted within fifteen (15) minutes of the conclusion of the day's play.

3 RULES OF PLAY

3.1 The Rules of Golf, as adopted by the R&A Ltd, shall apply together with the Golf Australia Hard Card and the Local Rules as drawn up by the Championship Committee.

4 ENTRIES

4.1 Entries shall only be made by completing the entry form available on the ASGC website or the front office.

4.2 The Entry Fee is detailed on the nomination form.

4.3 Eligible players are amateurs who must be a financial member of a recognised affiliated club in the country the player resides in and must have a Golf Australia or equivalent handicap at the time of play that does not exceed 36 for Men and 45 for women.

4.4 Your starting Handicap will remain locked in for the full Championship.

4.5 Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Championship Committee. Any such entry shall be subject to a late entry fee of \$20.00 per player.

4.6 It is the sole responsibility of the entrant himself to ensure that his entry is received prior to the closing time for entries.

4.7 In case of cancellation of the Alice Springs Open the Alice Springs Golf Club is only liable to refund the entry fee.

5 MOTORISED TRANSPORT

Alice Springs Championship Committee approves the use of motorized transport in the Alice Springs Open.

6 PACE OF PLAY

6.1 Rule 6-7 of the Rules of Golf will be strictly enforced. Further details can be found on the Golf Australia Hard Card.

7 CODE OF CONDUCT

7.1 All entrants assent to be bound by Golf NT's Code of Conduct. This code is available via the Golf NT website (<http://www.golfnt.org.au/>).

8. DRESS STANDARDS

8.1 Players and caddies must observe the dress standards and any course requirements of the ASGC.

10. DRAW AND STARTING TIMES

10.1 A draw for each days play will be made by the Championship Committee.

10.2 The Committee has the power to amend the draw or substitute another player for any competitor who is not at the tee at the time appointed to play. It may also alter the starting time for any player.

11. GOLF BALLS

11 It will be obligatory for all competitors in the Championship to play with a ball that is listed in the current R&A and/ or USGA Conforming Golf Balls. Penalty: Disqualification.

12. PRACTICE

12.1 Practice will not be permitted on the course between rounds of the Championship. Penalty: Disqualification.

13. DISTANCE MEASURING DEVICES

13.1 For all play on this course, a player may obtain distance information by using a device that measures distance only. If, during a *stipulated round*, a player uses a DMD that is designed to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect play (e.g. gradient, wind speed, temperature, a compass, etc.), the player is in breach Rule 14-3 whether or not the features are actually used. Penalty for breach of rule 14-3: disqualification.

The sporting showpiece of the unofficial capital of Central Australia is the stunning Alice Springs Golf Club which boasts one of the world's finest desert venues set in the foothills of the majestic MacDonnell Ranges. With several quality hotels backing onto the course, why not stay a couple of days and enjoy the magnificent scenery.

The Alice Springs course has earned rave reviews from golfers world-wide as a course of unique charm blended with some subtle severity. Accuracy is a must and even the boldest hitters must harness their power and replace it with discretion to ensure a safe landing, rather than challenge the menacing rocky outcrops which lurk at the edges of several of the fairways.

Australia's golfing legend, Peter Thomson, with his business partner, Michael Wolveridge, designed and constructed the course during the early 1980's. It is currently rated 46th in Australia by Australian Golf Course Guide, in the world's top ten desert courses and one of Australia's top 25 golf resorts.

The fully equipped Club provides a restaurant, bars, a well-stocked pro-shop, a floodlit driving range and putting green. Visitors are always welcome to enjoy the Course, Clubhouse facilities and views.

Due to current renovations to driving range and putting green these facilities may not be available during the time of the tournament.
