Purchased in 1954 by Associates to commemorate 50 years of managing their own affairs, authority for which was given in 1904.

36 hole Stroke play event played over two consecutive days.

OPEN EVENT - SEEDED DRAW

GA HANDICAP LIMIT: 14.0

Trophies awarded to Best 36 Hole Scratch Aggregate (Medal Winner), 2nd and 3rd place, 36 Hole Nett Aggregate Winner and 18 Hole Scratch and Nett Winners each day. A player can not win more than one prize per day.

In the event of a tie in the Scratch - joint winners.

In the event of a tie in the Nett - GA countback.

In the event of a tie in 18 holes Scratch and Nett events - countback.

JEAN DERRIN EVENT (Trophy presented by Golf NSW for players on GA handicaps 14 and under)

CONDITIONS OF PLAY

1. The AGC Medal is open to all Associate Amateurs with a GA handicap limit of 14.0.
2. The Rules of Golf and the Local Rules of The Australian Golf Club will be the Rules of Play for the Medal.
3. The Associates' Match Committee of The Australian Golf Club reserves the right to alter or make variations in the conditions or programme should it deem it desirable.
4. All disputes shall be settled by the Associates' Match Committee of The Australian Golf Club whose decision shall be final.
5. Motorised transport is not permitted, unless the player can provide a written opinion of a medical practitioner stating the nature of the disability and that by reason of the disability, the player would be unable to participate in the competition without using mechanical transport.
6. Tees will be reversed for the second day of play.
7. Handicapping will be processed on completion of 36 holes, therefore a players original handicap (subject to Rule 6-2b) shall apply to the 36 Holes Handicap Event as well as the second 18 holes event.
8. Any player who enters on a correct GA handicap within the prescribed limits at close of entries and whose handicap increases beyond the specified limit will be permitted to compete, however must play off the maximum handicap allowed for this event. Post entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Associates' Match Committee of The Australian Golf Club.
9. Entry Fees will not be refunded after the closing date.
10. Substitutions will not be allowed after the closing date.
11. Caddies are allowed.
12. Parking in the Visitors Car Park would be appreciated.
