PLAYER INFORMATION

FORMAT

SINGLES EVENTS

The singles event will be played in two divisions. The divisions are based on exact GA handicaps at close of entries. Players will play off their daily handicap as calculated on the day of the event. The divisions listed below are solely for the purpose of formulating the draw. Please see the draw to ensure you are aware of your correct division allocation. At close of entries the divisions were set as below:

Division 1 (Stroke) – GA Handicap of plus – 21.9

Division 2 (Stableford) – GA Handicap of 22.0 – 45.4

On the day of play, those whose GA Handicap is higher than the maximum handicap listed above will still play in the allocated Division, but will use the maximum handicap applicable. Those whose GA Handicap is lower than the minimum handicap listed above will still play in the allocated Division, and will use their current daily (playing) handicap for nett prizes.

FOURSOMES

The foursomes event will be played in two divisions. Pairings play off half the combined total of their daily handicaps.

Note: GOLF NSW Match Committee reserves the right to combine single entries to constitute a pair.

Trophy Presentation will be at conclusion of play.

Players may compete with any other player in the tournament. No handicap restrictions apply. Players may enter individually or in Teams of 2, 3 or 4. Players play off their daily (playing) handicap.

Trophy Presentation will be at conclusion of play.

Distance Measuring devices may be used, with the specimen local rule on page 136 of the Rules of Golf 2012-2016 in place.

PRIZES

Trophies will be limited to one 36-Hole trophy per player for the tournament and one 18-Hole trophy per player per day.

Division 1 – Singles Stroke Event

36-hole Tournament – Scratch winner, Nett winner and Nett runner-up

18-hole: Mon – Nett winner and runner-up, Tues – Nett winner and runner-up

Division 2 – Singles Stableford Event

36-hole Tournament - Stableford winner; runner-up and third place

18-hole: Mon – Winner and runner-up, Tues – Winner and runner-up

Foursomes - Divisions 1 and Division 2 - Stroke

18-hole Tournament – Nett winners and nett runners up in each Division; Division 1 Scratch winners

Four person Teams V Par (Two Courses)

Winners and runners-up awarded over the field at each course
