PLAYER INFORMATION

Practice rounds

Practice rounds can be booked through the pro shop on 6552 1506. There will be a club competition at Club Taree on Saturday 14 May. For further details please call the Pro Shop.

Format

Play will be from the 13th tee, from 7am. The Women's Championship will be 36-holes over two days. The Men's Championship will be 54-holes over three days, with a seeded draw for the final day of both Championships.

Registration

Please ensure you arrive at least 30 minutes prior to your tee time each day to register. Registration will be in the clubhouse, and must be done each day prior to commencing play. Following this, report to the starter at least 15 minutes prior to your tee time. Your score card, pin positions and local rules will be given to you on the tee.

Score card return and scoring

On completion of your round, please return your scorecard to the registration desk. Live scoring will be displayed in the clubhouse, as well as being available online at www.golfnsw.org.

Rules officials

There will be a roving rules official on course on each day of play. Please utilise them if you need to.

Food & Beverages at Club Taree

Club Taree will be open from 6.30am each morning, offering coffee and Bacon & Egg Rolls for purchase. There will also be lunch and dinner menus available during the Championship.

Sunday Welcome Dinner

There will be a Welcome Dinner on Sunday evening. This is included in the entry fee for all competitors. If additional people would like to attend the dinner it will be at a cost of \$40 per person and bookings must be made with Olivia Wilson as soon as possible at olivia.wilson@golfnsw.org.

Use of motorized carts

As per the conditions of entry, players may only use a motorized cart if a medical certificate is provided. This must be submitted to the Golf NSW office <u>prior to the tournament</u>. Bookings and payment for carts are the responsibility of the player.

Prizes

Competitors may win only one prize. Prizes will be awarded in the following order based on value:

Men's NSW Mid Amateur Championship

Winner, Runner Up and Third Place Scratch Winner and Runner Up Nett

Women's NSW Mid Amateur Championship

Winner and Runner Up Scratch Winner and Runner Up Nett Daily Nett Winner

Presentation

Presentation of Women's prizes will take place on completion of women's rounds on Monday. Presentation of Men's prizes will be on completion of play on Tuesday. If you are able to remain for this, please do so.

Withdrawal

If you are unable to participate, please notify us immediately. On presentation of a medical certificate a full refund will be issued, less an administration fee.

Conditions for State Events and Code of Conduct

The Golf NSW Standard Conditions for State Events and Code of Conduct will apply in accordance with the Championship Entry Conditions. A copy of the Standard Conditions and Code of Conduct is available from the Golf NSW website at www.golfnsw.org.

Player and Caddy Responsibilities

All Players and Caddies must adhere to commonly accepted standards of golfing etiquette and sportsmanship. Care of the course is an important aspect of etiquette and particular attention should be paid to the following:

- · Repair divots, carry and use a sand bucket
- · Repair pitch marks

A breach may lead to disqualification under Rule 33-7 and/or to disciplinary proceedings under the Golf NSW Code of Conduct. A player is responsible for the actions of their caddy.
