Players will be allocated into the following handicap divisions according to the **GA Handicap** as of the first day of play:

- **A-Grade** ~ ≤ 9.2
- **B-Grade** ~ 9.3 – 22.7

- **54-Hole Gross (A & B Grades)** – Winner, Runner-Up & Third Place
Note: Overall winner – Victorian Par 3 Champion
- **54-Hole Nett (A & B Grades)** – Winner & Runner-Up
- **First Hole-in-One** – set of car tyres (valued at \$600)
- **Daily NTP (multiple)**
- **36-Hole Teams' Event (Gross & Nett)** – Teams of 3

No player may win more than one trophy (exc. NTP & Teams Event).

Round 3 Seeded Draw

Please note a seeded draw will be created for the final day on the basis of 36-hole scores following conclusion of the first days play. The final round will commence via a multi-tee start at 9:00am on Sunday 12 June. The final round draw will be emailed to all players and made available on the Golf Victoria Website at www.golfvic.org.au, from 7:30pm on Saturday 11 June. Alternatively, players may call the GV Mobile on 0435 924 495 (Michelle).

Breakfast

Breakfast will be made available for all players competing in the championship from 7:00am Saturday 11 June and 7:30am on Sunday 12 June.

Lunch

Lunch will be provided to all players for all rounds of the championship. Round one lunch will be distributed from the registration/score card return area before the commencement of round two. Lunch will also be made available to players after the conclusion of round three. Please note that all other expenses will be the responsibility of the competitor.

Official Tournament Dinner – Saturday 11 June

All players and guests are invited to attend the optional tournament dinner at the Kyabram Club (Allan Street, Kyabram) on Saturday 11 June. The a la carte dinner will commence at approximately 6.30pm for a 7:00pm start with meals at menu prices.

Teams Event

A team's event, consisting of three players, will be optional but must be selected on Saturday 11 June **prior** to play. Prizes will be allocated according to 54 hole nett scores. Entry fee is \$3 per team.

Pull Buggies

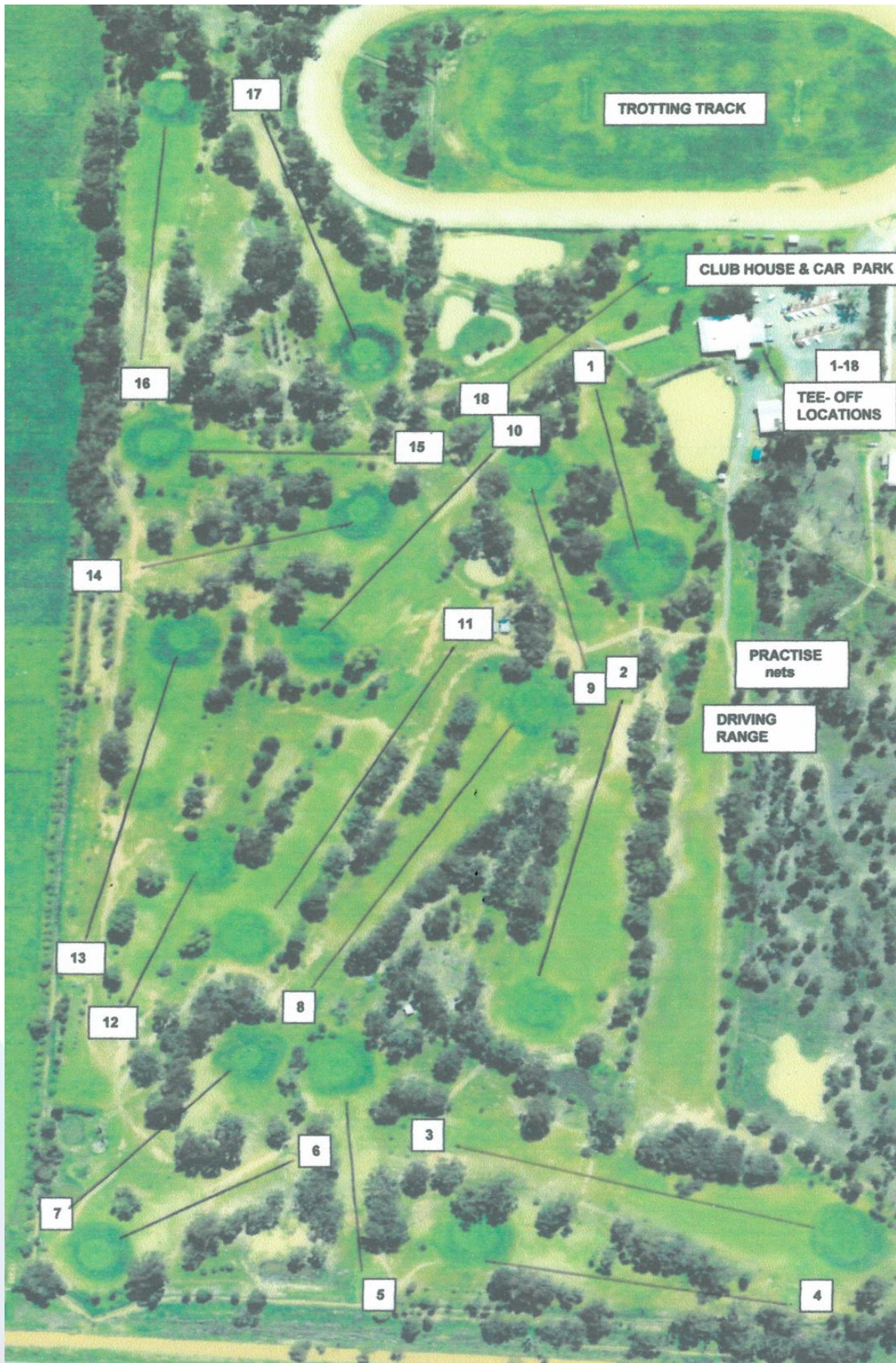
Only a limited number of push buggies are available at Kyabram Parkland, players are encouraged to bring their own buggy as required.

Scratchings

Any player wishing to scratch prior to Tuesday 7 June 2016 must ring GV tournaments on 8545 6207. After this date please call the GV mobile (Michelle) on **0435 924 495**.

Course Map

Players are requested to familiarise themselves with the course map to avoid any delay in commencement of play from allocated holes.



Registration

All competitors are required to report to Golf Victoria representatives inside the clubhouse upon arrival at the course. Players must then be present on the appropriate tee **no later than 10 minutes prior the tee time.**

Handicaps

All players must ensure that their current and correct daily handicap is recorded on the scorecard in accordance with Rule 6-2b. Players must play from their **DAILY** handicap during the Championship, with the exception that no player shall play from a GA handicap greater than the maximum limit of 22.7. Players shall play off their GA handicap as of round 1 for the entire competition. **Note: Cards will not be submitted to Golfink for handicapping until after the final round of competition.**

Scorecards

All score cards are to be returned to the registration area immediately at the conclusion of play.

Dress Regulations

All **players & caddies** are required to adhere to the Club's dress regulations with particular reference to the following: -

- ❖ Advertising or display materials must not appear on clothing except for brand name logos.
- ❖ All shirts must have a collar.
- ❖ Tailored shorts are permitted.
- ❖ Denim clothing of any description is not permitted.

Any player not adhering to the Host Clubs' dress regulations will be prohibited from playing. Any caddie or guest not adhering to the Host Clubs' dress regulations will be requested to leave the course.

Course Care / Club Regulations

Players are reminded that sand buckets **MUST** be taken and used and pitch marks are to be repaired. Mobile phones are not to be used in the clubhouse or on the course unless in the case of an emergency or a ruling during the round. Play will be from the nominated tee markers. Any player not complying with these requirements will be subject to action in accordance with the GV Code of Conduct.

Motorised Carts

According to GV's standard conditions of competitions, it is the responsibility of the player, if they require the use of a golf cart during the event to send a Medical Certificate and a completed copy of the Golf Victoria Motorised Transport Approval Return Form for consideration by the Match Committee. Please go to the GV website under *Rules & Handicapping* → *Motorised Transport* for the return form and more information. **Exemption:** Players aged 75 years and over do not require a Medical Certificate.

Note: Golf carts are not available for hire at the venue. Players may bring their own carts.

Slow Play

Rule 6-7 will be strictly enforced. Each group must maintain its position on the course with respect to the group preceding them. Any group with a clear hole in front of them will be considered out of position. Penalties will be issued to individuals in such groups who by their pace contribute to such delay. Warnings may not be issued prior to penalties.

Suspension of Play

In the event of heavy rain, lightning or for any other reason, the Championship Committee will be responsible for deciding whether to suspend play. The signal for suspending play will be one short siren blast. The procedure when play is suspended is outlined under Rule 6-8b. When the course is ready for play, players will be advised to return to various locations. The signal for the resumption of play will be one long siren blast.

Refunds

Any entrant may withdraw and have the entrance fee refunded provided notification is received within three working days prior to the event. Under no circumstances will entry fees be refunded after this date unless players can provide Golf Victoria supporting documents regarding their withdrawal from the event (ie. Medical certificate).

'Safe thru 18' – First Aid Information Guide for Golfers

Golf Victoria is aware that occasionally situations arise out on golf courses where first aid or emergency action is needed, and often golfers are unsure of the best way to respond.

A compact and comprehensive first aid guide titled "Safe thru 18" has been developed in a format that can easily fit into a player's bag. This guide provides information covering many situations that players may face out on course, both critical and common.
