CSGA OPEN ANNUAL CHAMPIONSHIPS CONDITIONS OF PLAY 2016

- 1. This event is open to all Amateur Women members of any golf club affiliated with GA and clubs recognised by the bodies governing Women's Golf in overseas countries.
- 2. The Championships is a two day stroke competition for Divisions 1 and 2, and a stableford competition for Divisions 3 and 4. Day 3 will be played as 4BBB.
- 3. Junior players entering the Championships will compete stroke play.
- 4. The number of Divisions and breakdown will be decided once all entries have been received.
- **5.** Team's event (not Scratch) entries and the Eila Fraser trophy will have gross scores converted to stableford where the players entering are subject to stroke conditions.
- **6.** Scratch events can only be determined if the player is competing in stroke play.
- 7. The CSGA Match Committee has complete control of this event and reserves the right to vary conditions should it be deemed necessary. The decision of the CSGA Match Committee on all points of protest shall be final.
- **8.** Competitors must report to the starter at least 15 minutes prior to their scheduled hit off time. Failure may result in a two shot penalty or disqualification. See R&A Rules of Golf 6-3a and 33-7.
- **9.** Handicaps are to be GA or certified by the governing Women's Golf body in the player's country of residence. A player's handicap will remain the same for Day one and two of the competition.
- 10. The Rules of Golf and the local rules of the host Club shall be the rules of play during this tournament.
- **11.** Mobile phones may be carried on the course only if switched off or in the silent mode. Mobile phones may be used on the course in case of an *emergency*, i.e. to make an outgoing call. The use of a mobile phone outside these parameters by a competitor or her caddy is prohibited. Refer GNSW Conditions of Play.
- **12.** Motorised Transport is permitted. The CSGA Committee takes no responsibility for the provision of motorised transport and players should make their own arrangements and bookings with respective club Pro Shops.
- 13. Ties in all handicap events shall be decided using the GA method of count back.
- **14.** Ties in team events will be declared joint winners.
- **15.** Competitors are limited to one trophy per day, excluding Special Event trophies, with scratch event trophies taking precedence over nett events.
- **16.** It is the responsibility of the competitor to comply with the dress regulations of the host Club.
- **17.** Players must abide by the GNSW Standard Conditions of Play and Code of Conduct as published on the GNSW web site www.golfnsw.org and available at all affiliated Clubs.
