



Volunteer Position Descriptions

Position Title: Fixed Hole Marshall

Description: Rotate around a specific hole managing public and player walkways

Key Responsibilities: Marshalls are predominantly responsible for managing spectator movement and

noise control around high profile tees and greens.

Marshalls are supplied 'quiet' batons to assist them with crowd noise control.

Some marshalls may be assigned to high traffic areas to assist players moving from

Green to Tee.

Attributes: Ability to give clear and concise direction to spectators.

A loud controlled voice with suitable cut-through to gain attention when required.

Ability to think and act logically with player and spectator safety in mind.

Sound knowledge and etiquette of the game of golf.

Time commitment: Preferably a minimum of two days over the four-day tournament.

Duration of shifts are approximately:

7:30 am to 1.00 pm

OR

1.00 pm to 6.00 pm

A group of club members can manage or "own" one hole for one or more days during the event
