## About

The Royal Women's Hospital (RWH) 4BBB Stableford Competition is a state-wide competition that raises money to train a specialist doctor in urogynaecology for the pelvic-floor dysfunction unit at the RWH. The event commenced in 2005 to commemorate the centenary year of the former Women's Golf Victoria. All funds raised through this event are donated to the RWH Foundation.

From 2006 to 2015 the 4 Ball Best Ball plus the Annual Charity Day events have raised over \$200,000 for the hospital through the participation and donations of approximately 25,000 Victorian women golfers.

## Motorised Cart Hire

Competitors are permitted to ride in or on a motorised vehicle during any round of the Championship. Players are advised that the use of personal motorised carts is **prohibited** at Rosanna Golf Club. A total of **eight carts** are available for hire, players wishing to make a booking are advised to contact **(Glenn)** at Golf Victoria on (03) 8545 6218 as soon as possible.

## Scratchings

Any player wishing to scratch prior to Friday 7 October must ring GV Tournaments on (03) 8545 6218. To scratch on the day of play please call the GV mobile on **0402 082 814 (Glenn)**.





## Registration

All competitors are required to report to Golf Victoria representatives upon arrival at the course at least 30 minutes prior to their tee time. Players must then be present for the briefing prior to making their way to the respective starting hole.

## Handicaps & Scoring

All players must ensure that their current and correct handicap is recorded on the scorecard in accordance with Rule 6-2b. Players must play from their current **DAILY** handicap during the Championship, with the exception that no player shall play from a GA handicap greater than the maximum limit 45.4. In addition, all pairs must ensure that each hole score is individually identifiable in accordance with Rule 31-4.

## Scorecards

All score cards are to be returned to the registration area situated in the clubhouse immediately at the conclusion of play.

## Dress Regulations

All **players and caddies** are required to adhere to the Club's dress regulations with particular reference to the following: -

- ❖ Clean dress shoes **MUST** be worn in the clubhouse at all times. Athletic jogger shoes are not permitted.
- ❖ Advertising or display materials must not appear on clothing except for brand name logos.
- ❖ All shirts must have a collar.
- ❖ Tailored shorts are permitted.
- ❖ Denim clothing of any description is not permitted.

Any player not adhering to the Host Clubs' dress regulations will be prohibited from playing. Any caddie or guest not adhering to the Host Clubs' dress regulations will be requested to leave the course.

## Golf Footwear

Players are requested to note that soft spikes are mandatory.

## Course Care / Club Regulations

Players are reminded that sand buckets **MUST** be taken and used, pitch marks are to be repaired, and bunkers raked following play at each course. Mobile phones are not to be used in the clubhouse or on the course unless in the case of an emergency or a ruling during the round. Play will be from the nominated tee markers. Any player not complying with these requirements will be subject to action in accordance with the GV Code of Conduct.

## Slow Play

Rule 6-7 will be strictly enforced. Each group must maintain its position on the course with respect to the group preceding them. Any group with a clear hole in front of them will be considered out of position. Penalties will be issued to individuals in such groups who by their pace contribute to such delay. Warnings may not be issued prior to penalties.

## Suspension of Play

In the event of heavy rain, lightning or for any other reason, the Championship Committee will be responsible for deciding whether to suspend play. The signal for suspending play will be a verbal command over the public address system. The procedure when play is suspended is outlined under Rule 6-8b. When the course is ready for play, players will be advised to return to various locations. The signal for the resumption of play will be a verbal command over the public address system.

## Safe thru 18' – First Aid Information Guide for Golfers

Golf Victoria is aware that occasionally situations arise out on golf courses where first aid or emergency action is needed, and often golfers are unsure of the best way to respond.

A compact and comprehensive first aid guide titled "Safe thru 18" has been developed in a format that can easily fit into a player's bag. This guide provides information covering many situations that players may face out on course, both critical and common.
