PLAYER INFORMATION

FORMAT

SINGLES EVENTS

The singles event will be played in two divisions. The divisions are based on exact GA handicaps at close of entries. Players will play off their daily handicap as calculated on the day of the event. The divisions listed below are solely for the purpose of formulating the draw. Please see the draw to ensure you are aware of your correct division allocation. At close of entries the divisions were set as below:

Division One – GA Handicap of plus to 24.9

Division Two – GA Handicap of 25.0 to 45.4

On the day of play, those whose GA Handicap is higher than the maximum handicap listed above will still play in the allocated Division, but will use the maximum handicap applicable. Those whose GA Handicap is lower than the minimum handicap listed above will still play in the allocated Division, and will use their current daily (playing) handicap for nett prizes.

FOURSOMES

Wednesday 19 October

The foursomes event will be played in two divisions. The divisions are based on exact GA handicaps at close of entries. Please see the draw to ensure you are aware of your correct division allocation. Pairings play off half the combined total of their daily handicaps. At close of entries the divisions were set as below:

Division One at Leura Golf Club – GA Handicap of plus to 26.4 (half combined)

Division Two at Blackheath Golf Club – GA Handicap of 26.5 to 45.4 (half combined)

As for the singles event, on the day of play, those who's GA Handicap is higher than the maximum handicap listed above will still play in the allocated Division, but will use the maximum handicap applicable. Those whose GA Handicap is lower than the minimum handicap listed above will still play in the allocated Division, and will use their current daily (playing) handicap for nett prizes.

Note: GOLF NSW Match Committee reserves the right to combine single entries to constitute a pair.

Trophy Presentation will be at conclusion of play.

BEST BALL TEAMS EVENT V PAR

Division 2 – Singles Stableford Event

36-hole Tournament – Stableford winner, runner-up and third place
18-hole: Mon – Winner and runner-up, Tues – Winner and runner-up

Foursomes - Divisions 1 and Division 2 – Stroke

18-hole Tournament – Nett winners and nett runners up in each Division; Division 1 Scratch winners

Four person Teams V Par

Winners and runners-up awarded over the field at each course

Distance Measuring devices may be used, with the specimen local rule on page 136 of the Rules of Golf 2012-2016 in place.

PLAYER AND CADDY RESPONSIBILITIES

All Players and Caddies must adhere to commonly accepted standards of golfing etiquette and sportsmanship. Care of the course is an important aspect of etiquette and particular attention should be paid to the following:

- Repair divots, carry and use a sand bucket
- Repair pitch marks

A breach may lead to disqualification under Rule 33-7 and/or to disciplinary proceedings under the Golf NSW Code of Conduct. A player is responsible for the actions of their caddy.
