In 1974 the South Australian Golf Association (SAGA) introduced the Vardon competition, with the winner being decided on averages calculated over a number of events.

Women's Golf South Australia, introduced its Vardon series in 1976 and was based on a points system.

The Junior Boys Vardon has been running since 1981.

The formation of Golf SA in 2008 has seen the Vardon revised and merged into a single competition based on the same conditions of play.

The Vardon is ranked as one of the most prestigious Amateur golf competitions in the State.

The 2016 Junior Boy's Vardon Series included:

- 10 Club Vardons
- 3 Golf SA Junior Opens
- the State Junior Amateur Championship
- and the State National Junior Ranking event - the SA Junior Masters

Finishing:

3rd	with an average of 74.00	was Jackson Kalz (Glenelg)
2nd	with an average of 73.42	was Joe Hodgson (Kooyonga)
