COMPETITON CONDITIONS

- 1. The Tournament Committee of The Flinders Golf Club shall have sole responsibility for the Management of the Tournament.
- 2. Entry fee must be paid at the time of entry.
- 3. The competition is open to players who have a GA handicap of 10 or under at the time of entry.
- 4. Players must be prepared to play when called upon to do so by the Tournament Committee and shall report to the starter on the players designated tee at least 15 minutes prior to their hit off time. Play will be from the 1st and 10th tees.
- 5. The competition shall be played in accordance with the rules of golf as adopted by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St. Andrews, Scotland, together with such Local Rules as are in force at the time of the event.
- 6. If a dispute arises at any point it shall be decided by the Tournament Committee in charge of the competition, whose decision shall be final.
- 7. Any dispute or protest must be lodged in writing at the Clubhouse before 6.30pm on the day of the competition.
- 8. The Tournament Committee may, in the event of bad weather, or for any other reason, shorten the contest or schedule another day.
- 9. In the circumstance of a Tie in any of the events the result of the tied event will be determined by scorecard countback. The method of countback for 36 holes will be the final 18 holes whereby the player with the lowest cumulative score over the last 18, 9, 6, 3 or 1 hole(s) is declared the winner. For Event 2 the 36 holes net winner handicap will be used to determine the final result.
