Conditions of play

- **1. Handicaps -** Each competitor must be a member of an affiliated golf club and hold a current GA handicap.
- **2. Rules of play -** The Rules of Golf and the local rules of Pennant Hills Golf Club shall apply. The local rules appear on the scorecard and the notice board outside the pro shop.
- **3. Metal spikes -** Metal spikes are not permitted.
- **4. Ties -** In the event of a tie the GA Countback System will be used.
- 5. Caddies Caddies are not permitted except when a medical certificate advises it.
- **6. Motorised transport -** A player may use motorised transport during this event. Please book through the pro shop on 02 8860 5860.
- 7. Distance measuring devices The use of GPS devices is allowed during the event.
- 8. Registration All players shall report to the pro shop at least 20 minutes prior to their allocated tee time.
- 9. Sand buckets All players, including those carrying bags, must carry and use a sand bucket.
- **10. Slow play -** Officials will monitor the pace of play. Penalties will be strictly enforced. First offence Warning; Second offence 2 stroke penalty; Third offence Disqualification.
- **11. Dress rules -** On the golf course tailored golf attire must be worn and shirts must have a collar. Within the clubhouse smart casual attire may be worn.
- 12. Buggies Only wide buggy wheels permitted on the course.
- **13. Time sheet** The draw will be available on the Pennant Hills Golf Club website (refer Visitor section) from Wednesday 15th February.
- **14. Weather -** In the event where the course is deemed unplayable due to extreme weather conditions, please refer to the guest section of the website for notification.
- **15. Entry fees -** Entry fees are non-refundable after the closing date unless supported by a medical certificate (\$10 administration fee will be charged).
- 16. Late entries Late entries will be accepted subject to availability.
- 17. Spectators Spectators are allowed but may not act in the capacity of a caddy.
