Format: 72-holes, Stroke-Play. In the event of a tie, a sudden-death playoff will take

place. The leading 70 players and ties after 36 holes will qualify for the 3rd

and 4th rounds.

The field of 144 players will be determined as follows:

- 1. 100 LPGA members who have committed to the event in order of priority on the LPGA Priority List (including the winner of the Pure-Silk Bahamas LPGA Classic if not already qualified).
- 2. 20 places as agreed between ALPG and GA, not including those who qualify in 1 above.
- 3. The winner of the 2017 RACV Gold Coast Challenge and the winner of the 2017 Oates Victorian Open, along with an additional exemption for the leading money winner across both events (including non ALPG members). Should the winners of either event already be exempt, the exemption applies to the next player not already exempt on this money list. (Money list includes all non ALPG members).
- 4. Five (5) ISPS Exemptions
- 5. Four (4) Swinging Skirt Exemptions
- 6. One (1) JGOLF Exemption
- 7. Five (5) Golf Australia Invitations
- 8. Three (3) Golf Australia Amateur Exemptions as follows:
 - i. 2017 Australian Amateur Champion
 - ii. 2016 Australian Girls' Amateur Champion
 - iii. 2016 Aaron Baddeley World Junior Champion
- 9. Three (3) players from qualifying

NOTE: After the commitment deadline on 4 January 2017, ALL withdrawals are managed by LPGA

ACCOMMODATION

CADDIES

Players are not permitted to use a pull buggy/trolley and must have a caddie.

The fee for a local caddie is AUD \$90.00 daily, not including gratuity.

Players requiring a caddie must complete the relevant section when entering or contact Adam Power at Golf Australia (Ph +61 3 9626 5000 / Fax +61 3 9696 5095 / championships@golf.org.au).

Note: Each player who requests a caddie is asked, if she subsequently decides to provide her own caddie, to notify Golf Australia immediately about her decision not to use the allocated caddie. Caddies will not be provided for those players who do not advise at the time of entry or contact Golf Australia.

Note: A professional caddie may assist with yardages, etc. a Bag Carrier will only carry the bag.

<u>Caddie requests MUST be received by Golf Australia prior to 5:00 pm on Friday 10 February</u> 2017.

NB. The tournament organisers will make every effort to cater for the particular type of caddie a player requests, but cannot guarantee that the specific caddie will be available.





CLUB FACE GROOVE REGULATIONS

The following regulation applies to the Championship Proper only:

Clubs Conforming with Groove and Punch Mark Specifications: The player's clubs must conform to the groove and punch mark specifications in the Rules of Golf that are effective from 1 January 2010.

*PENALTY FOR CARRYING, BUT NOT MAKING STROKE WITH, CLUB OR CLUBS IN BREACH OF CONDITION: Two strokes for each hole at which a breach occurred; maximum penalty per round – four strokes. *Any club or clubs carried in breach of this condition must be declared out of play by the player to their marker or fellow competitor immediately upon discovery a breach has occurred. If the player fails to do so, they are disqualified.

PENALTY FOR MAKING STROKE WITH CLUB IN BREACH OF CONDITION: Disqualification.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR ALL PLAYERS AND CADDIES - VISA APPLICATIONS

Players, caddies and guests traveling with the following passport (United States, Europe, Canada, South Korea and Japan) will only need to file for an ETA tourist visa to enter Australia. https://assessments.visabureay.com/australia

You do not need to surrender your Passport, but you must complete the form and submit electronically to receive a confirmation. The ETA is electronically linked to your Passport.

ALL others are advised to ensure their visa requirements are in order before travelling.

If filing for Visa on your own, please log onto the Australian Embassy Website www.australianembassy.com.au or your country's web site for details on how to apply and what information is required.

GOLF CLUBS

Australian Customs require all golf clubs and golf shoes entering from international destinations to be clean and free of dirt or mud. To ensure an efficient entry into Australia, please ensure all golf equipment has been thoroughly cleaned.
