

CONDITIONS OF THE COMPETITION

- 1. **Entrance fee MUST** accompany the Entry Form. Entry fee for the event may only be refunded at the sole discretion of the Match Committee of the Box Hill Golf Club.
- Entries to the event must be directed to the Tournament Secretary, Box Hill Golf Club, 202 Station Street, Box Hill, 3128 and must be received no later than the close of business on MONDAY 16 January, 2017. Draw will be available 48 hours prior to the event on the club website – <u>www.boxhillgolfclub.com.au</u> or ring the office on 9808 1526
- 3. Entries are restricted to Amateur Golfers who hold a Golf Australia handicap recognised by Golf Australia.
- 4. Dress Rules as listed below
- 5. Competition shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as adopted by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St. Andrews, Scotland, together with such local rules as are in force on the course over which the competition takes place.
- All protests or disputes shall be dealt with by the Match Committee of the Box Hill Golf Club, whose decision will be final, and any such protest or dispute must be lodged in writing with the Match Committee within 30 minutes from time of return of the final competitor's score card.
- 7. The Match Committee of the Box Hill Golf Club shall have the <u>entire</u> management of the tournament and full power to alter or vary these conditions (except clauses 3, 4 & 6) and handicap divisions at their discretion.
- 8. The Match Committee may, in the event of bad weather, or for any other reason, either shorten any competition or postpone it to another day.
- 9. Competitors shall be drawn to play in such manner as the Match Committee arranges and must be prepared to play when called upon.
- 10. In the event of a tie: the Golf Australia approved count back method will apply.

11. Shotgun Start at 7.30am.

DRESS - ON COURSE:

- Golf attire which should be neat, clean, comfortable and appropriate to the conditions.
- > Trousers and shorts must be of a style designed to be worn with a belt and have a zipper.
- Shirts which are collarless must be golf specific.
- Shirts may be worn loose and not tucked in.
- Socks/Sockettes when worn with shorts (or other clothing that renders the socks or sockettes visible) must be predominantly white. If long socks are worn with shorts, then they must be pulled up and secured.
- > All hats must be worn as intended by their manufacturers design.
- Soft Spiked golf shoes only.
- Appropriate Women's skirts, shorts, long pants.

The Directors or their delegate(s) reserve the right to determine what is "neat, clean, comfortable and appropriate to the conditions".

Boys and girls will compete in a single competition; boys will use the White markers and girls the Red Markers.
