Event Outline

- ◆ The Kew Junior Open will be played over 18 holes stroke play for a maximum of 100 players.
- ◆ Play will commence via a multi-tee start, commencing at 12.30pm
- ◆ Handicap Limit: 36 (Boys), 45 (Girls)
- ◆ Entrance Fee:
 - \$30.00 (GST Inclusive), includes light meal following the round
- ◆ Nearest to Pins
- ◆ Entries Close at 5.00pm on Monday 16th January, 2016 or when capacity field is reached.
- ◆ Trophies will be awarded for the following:-
 - Overall Gross Winner & Runner-Up for both boys and girls
 - Overall Nett Winner & Runner-Up for both boys and girls
 - Nett Winners and Runners-Up in the following age groups:
 - Under 16 Boys
 - Under 14 Boys

2017 KEW JUNIOR OPEN – CONDITIONS



1. THE KEW JUNIOR OPEN

- 1.1. Eligible players are male and female amateurs, who are aged under 18 as at the 19th January, 2017.
- 1.2. The Tournament will be played over 18 holes in a stroke format.
- 1.3. The field for the Tournament will be limited to 100 players and accepted on a receipt of entry basis.
- 1.4. The winning boy and girl with the lowest stroke score shall be the Kew Junior Open Champions and shall receive a trophy. The runners-up shall also receive a trophy.
- 1.5. The winning boy and girl with the lowest Nett score shall be the Kew Junior Handicap Champions and shall receive a trophy. The runners-up shall also receive a trophy.
- 1.6. There will be trophies awarded to the Nett winners and runners-up for boys in the following age groups:-
Boys
- Under 16 and Under 14
Note: A minimum of five players will be required for trophies to be awarded for a specific age/gender group. The Committee reserves the right to redefine age/gender groups should this situation occur
- 1.7. Additional trophies will be awarded as follows:
- Nearest to Pins for:
- Boys (18th) - Girls (11th)
- 1.8. All ties shall be decided by count-back as recommended by Golf Australia. In the event of a tie, a count back will determine the winner.
- 1.9. The player who wins a trophy in the overall section will be ineligible to win a trophy in their respective age/gender group.

2. EVENT COMMITTEE:

The Event Committee shall consist of representatives of the Kew Golf Club and an additional person(s) as may be nominated by the Kew Match Committee. In the absence of the full Event Committee, such members thereof as may be present at any time may give a decision of the full Event Committee. The Event Committee reserves the right to vary any condition of this event.

In the event of bad weather, or for any other reason, the Event Committee may shorten the competition, appoint another day or days for completion.

Protests must be made to the Event Committee not later than 10 minutes after the conclusion of each round. The decision of the Event Committee will be final in all matters relating to the Tournament.

3. ENTRIES:

The Event Committee shall have the right to refuse the entry of any person without being required to give any reason for such refusal. Entrance fees must be paid at the time of entry. Any entrant may withdraw and have his entrance fee refunded providing that notification is received by the time that entries close. All entries must be accompanied by either a current handicap record verified by the club or GolfLink Number. Entries shall only be made on the official entry form unless otherwise permitted by the Event Committee.

4. RULES:

The competition shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as adopted by R&A Rules Limited, together with such local rules as are in force on the

course over which the competition round is being played. If any dispute arises on any point, it shall be decided by the Event Committee whose decision shall be final. All players are required to adhere to the Kew Code of Conduct for the duration of the competition.

5. DRAW AND STARTING TIME:

A draw will be made by the Event Committee. The Committee has the power to amend the draw or substitute another player for any competitor who is not at the tee at the time of tee off. However, it is a condition of the competition that, in the absence of circumstances which warrant waiving the penalty of disqualification as provided in Rule 33-7, if the player arrives at his starting point, ready to play within five minutes of his starting time, the penalty for failure to start on time is two strokes at the first hole in stroke play instead of disqualification.

6. HONORARY MEMBERS:

Competitors will be made Honorary Members of the Kew Golf Course for the day.

7. PRACTICE:

Practice is **not** available at the Kew Golf Club prior to the event.

8. MOTORISED TRANSPORT:

During play, it is prohibited for a player or his caddie to ride in or on a motorised vehicle unless specific written permission has been granted by the Event Committee. Penalty: deduction penalty two strokes at the first hole. Procedure when breach discovered: Use of any unauthorised form or transportation must be discontinued immediately upon discovery that a breach has occurred. Otherwise the player is disqualified.

9. PACE OF PLAY:

Rule 6-7 will be strictly enforced. Each group must maintain its position on the course with respect to the group preceding them. Any group with a clear hole in front of them will be considered out of position. Penalties will be issued to individuals in such groups who by their pace contribute to such delay. Warnings may not be issued prior to penalties.

10. DRESS STANDARDS:

Players and caddies must observe the dress standards of Kew Golf Club.

11. DATABASE OF COMPETITOR'S DETAILS:

- 11.1 The data contained on an entry form submitted by an entrant for Kew Golf event is permanently retained by the Club within its database of competitor's details.
- 11.2 This database is operated to assist with the management of current and future Kew events.
- 11.3 From time to time players may be sent entry forms or event literature for Kew events, and accompanying material.
- 11.4 Upon receipt by the Kew Golf Club of a written request, a player may either have access to their details, or have their details deleted from the database.
