CONDITIONS OF PLAY

- This tournament is open to all junior golfers under the age of 18 years & 18-20 year olds (in their own category) who possess a GA handicap.
- The event is a 36 hole stroke in divisions for the boys and for the girls.
- Caboolture Golf Club reserves the right to accept or refuse any entry.
- Caboolture Golf Club reserves the right to alter conditions of play at any time.
- Please adhere to the dress regulations of the Caboolture Golf Club.
- Competition shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf, together with such Local Rules as are in force at the Caboolture Golf Club.
- All players must use a golf ball which is named, tested and approved as per the current R & A approved list of conforming golf balls.
- Competitors must be ready to start at the appointed time Rule 6-3a.
- Ties for gross champions in all divisions will be a sudden death play-off on the 18th hole.
- All other ties will be decided by the Golf Australia count-back system.
- ♦ The Match Committee of the Caboolture Golf Club will settle any dispute or protest which must be submitted in writing to them within 15 minutes of leaving the last green
- The audible emission or unauthorised use of a mobile phone on the golf course or during play is a serious breach of etiquette and will attract a warning and possible disqualification (Rule 33-7) (Players& Caddies).
- Motorised transport is not permitted unless a medical certificate states otherwise.
- Caddies are allowed (Professional caddies are not permitted).
- ♦ SLOW PLAY penalties will apply (Rule 6-7). Each group must maintain their position on the course with respect to the preceding group. Any group losing one clear fairway will be considered out of position. Penalties may be issued to players in such groups who by their pace contribute to such delay. Warnings may not be issued prior to penalties.
- Caboolture Golf Club must be notified of any withdrawals prior to the tournament, phone 5495 1033.
- Late nominations will be accepted if times are available.
