

Conditions Of Entry GROUP 4

- a) Entries will be limited to 34 teams of 4 players and all entries will be recorded in order of receipt. When capacity is reached, applications will be placed on a waiting list, and applicants advised.
- b) One (1) shotgun start will be conducted at 9.00 am.
- c) All registration fees must be paid with the Registration Form. Refunds will be made for cancellations made 2 weeks or more prior to the event. Refunds for cancellations within 2 weeks of the event will be at the discretion of the organising committee. All refunds will be made after the completion of SA Group 4 Clubs Stableford Championships.
- d) Play will be governed by the Rules of Golf (as approved by R&A Rules Ltd), Golf Australia and such Local Rules as shall apply. Disputes shall be decided by the Tournament Match Committee and its decisions shall be binding and final.
- e) Only players with official Golf Australia (GA) sanctioned handicaps may enter this event. Handicap limits are: Men G.A. 24.0 and Female G.A. 31.9.
- f) The SA Group 4 Clubs Stableford Championships will consist of one Stableford round. Players will be nominated in Teams of 4.
Teams to consist of: Men – Team of 4: Women – Team of 4: Mixed – Any configuration.

As an aggregate Stableford competition all 4 individual player's scores will be added together to determine Team Aggregate Score. The Tournament Committee reserves the right when conducting the draw, to place 2 players from one team with 2 players from another team, for the competition.

- g) For individual player competition requirements, grades will be determined as follows:

Men	A Grade	0 to 12 handicap
	B Grade	13 to 18 handicap
	C Grade	19 to 27 handicap

Ladies – One grade only, unless numbers require additional grades to be included. Grade handicap limits may be adjusted before the SA Group 4 Clubs Stableford Championships to ensure that there are approximately equal numbers of players in each grade.
- h) Tied results shall be decided using Golf Australia countback procedures.
- i) Team Captains will be required to report to the starter at least 20 minutes before the tee off time.
- j) Motorised transport is allowed for this event.
- k) Dress Rules: Players and their caddies must comply with the Victor Harbor Golf Club's dress rules; non compliance could result in a player not being allowed to start or asked to leave the course.
- l) Individual prizes will be allocated to Men & Women (depending on numbers). Trophies will be presented to the Winner (player with the highest Stableford score) in each Grade. Other trophies will be presented to Runner – Up. Runner – up prizes will be awarded in Women's grades, depending on the numbers of players entered. NTP's will be available on each Par 3 hole and Long Drive prizes available to each grade, both men & women. Players can only win one (1) major prize (Place getters in team event cannot win individual event).
- m) Major Championships prizes will include:
The SA Group 4 Clubs Stableford Championship Trophy will be presented to the team with the highest aggregate team score. Other trophies will be presented to Runners – Up, and 3rd place.

The Course & Match Sub Committee is responsible for setting the competition dates, setting the entry cost, setting the closing date, setting the draw, setting the prizes and running the event.
