COMPETITION CONDITIONS

- Entrance fee must be fully paid to Cranbourne Golf Club by Friday March 31st, 2017. Refunds will not be made for cancellations received after the closing date.
- The event is to be played over 18 holes stroke (h'cap up to 20) and 18 holes stableford (h'cap 21+) and is open to Amateurs who have an official Golf Australia handicap and are under 18 years of age as at 1 January, 2017. Entries shall only be made on the official entry form unless otherwise permitted by the Tournament Committee.
- The field will be limited to a maximum of 108 participants. Should it be necessary to limit the field, ballot will be decided on order of receipt of entry.
- The event shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as adopted by R&A Rules Limited, together with such Local Rules as are in force on the course over which the competition rounds are being played
- The use of distance measuring devices is permitted, as per Local Rules
- The Tournament Committee reserves the right to vary any condition of this event. In the event of inclement weather or for any other reason, the Tournament Committee may shorten the event or arrange an alternate day. Protests must be made to the Tournament Committee no later than 10 minutes after the conclusion of the round. The decision of the Tournament Committee will be final in all matters relating to the event. If any dispute arises on any point, it shall be decided by the Tournament Committee whose decision shall be final. In addition, all players are required to adhere to Golf Victoria's Code of Conduct for the duration of the Tournament
- A competitor is not eligible to win more than one 18 HOLE EVENT. In the event of a tie, there will be a count back as per Golf Australia regulations.
- Players and caddies must observe the dress standards and any course requirement of Cranbourne Golf Club. Neat golf attire (NO denim, NO cargo pants/shorts) and non-metal spikes are compulsory on course. Golf or neat casual attire is required in the Clubhouse.
- Rule 6-7 will be strictly enforced. Each group must maintain its position on the course with respect to the group preceding them. Any group with a clear hole in front of them will be considered out of position. Penalties will be issued to individuals in such groups who by their pace contribute to such delay. Warnings may not be issued prior to penalties.
- List of all entries received will be available to view on the Cranbourne Golf Club website <u>www.cranbournegolf.com.au</u> (Guest section) and the draw will e-mailed to all participants and on the website by 5pm Tuesday 4th April, 2017.
- The data contained on an entry form submitted by an entrant for the event is permanently retained by Cranbourne and may be used for promotion of future events. During the event, players may have their photo taken which may be displayed on the website and other promotional material. Any player not wishing to have their photo displayed or their details retained should inform Cranbourne Golf Club.
- The course will be available for practice rounds at a reduced green fee of \$25 per person on Monday April 3rd (PM) and Tuesday April 4th (PM). Times must be booked by contacting the Club's Pro Shop on (03) 5991 3456 and are subject to availability.
