

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- Events are open to amateur golfers having a current Australian handicap with an affiliated golf club.
- 2. Handicap divisions covering all events to be determined by the Tournament Committee after receipt of entries. (as a guide, the cut-off for A Grade in 2016 was a GA Handicap of 6.5)
- 3. Unless full **Golf Link number** is provided a handicap card must be available for perusal by the Committee.
- 4. The Tournament Committee has the sole control of the Tournament. Any dispute or protest will be decided by the Tournament Committee and their decision will be final (Rule 34-3)
- 5. Only one trophy may be won per person per event.
- 6. The Rules of Golf and Local Rules apply for the duration of the Tournament.
- 7. No card will be accepted after results have been declared. The results will be posted on the ClubCatalina Country Club website.
- 8. In the event of a tie, a play-off will decide the winner of the 36 hole Stroke event. The top 12 players from Saturday (Rd1) will be seeded on Sunday (Rd2).
- 9. Full player details must be nominated on the entry form or photocopy of the entry form and accompanied by cheque, money order, cash or credit card payment.
- 10. Entries close at 4:00pm Monday April 17, 2017 for all events or when capacity field is reached.
- 11. Preferred start times allocated to entries as they are received.
- 12. All players must report to the starter 15 minutes before hit-off time. Any player not adhering to this condition may be disqualified.
- 13. Late entries for the 36 holes event will be accepted if vacancies exist.
- 14. The Committee reserves the right to alter any condition should this action become necessary. Subject to entry numbers, a shotgun start may be utilised on Sunday.

GENERAL CONDITIONS

- A copy of the draw will be listed on our website in the preceding week. Results will
 also be listed on our website after the conclusion of the 3 days. Daily results will be
 displayed on the clubhouse notice board.
- 2. In accordance with the prevailing laws it is necessary for each visitor to sign in on their arrival. Contact club reception for any assistance. All the facilities of the clubhouse are available to you during your visit.
- 3. Cancellations and refunds: no refunds will be made for any cancellation received less than 7 days before the first day of the Tournament. Cancellations on medical grounds or incapacity may be given special consideration. If a refund is made, a booking fee of five dollars (\$5) will be retained. Substitutes must be authorised by the Tournament Director at his/her discretion (an additional entry fee will apply).

The personal data contained in an entry form is permanently retained by Golf NSW. This data may be utilised by Golf NSW or its sponsors for the distribution of correspondence, in both electronic and hard copy means. From time to time players may be sent Entry Forms, event literature, the Golf NSW e-newsletter, or marketing material by the sponsor (s) of Golf NSW events, or information about events conducted by Golf NSW-approved bodies. Upon receipt of Golf NSW of a written request, a player ,may either have access to their details, or have their details deleted from the database.
