IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Format

Day 1 – Sunday 19 March – 18 holes strokeplay – 1st and 11th tees from 8.30am – 10.10am.

Day 2 – Monday 20 March – 18 holes strokeplay – 1st and 11th tees from 8.30am – 10.10am.

Day 3 – Tuesday 21 March – 18 holes match play for those that qualify in the following divisions:

- (a) Championship Match Play: leading four scratch scores from the entire field
- (b) Age Division Match Play: from those not qualifying for (a), the leading four scratch scores for players aged 55-64, 65-74, 75+.
- (c) Handicap Match Play: from those not qualifying in (a) or (b) above, the leading four nett scores for players in Div 1 (H'caps to 19) and Div II (H'caps 20+).

Day 4 – Wednesday 22 March – 18 holes match play finals (for those that won their matches on Day 3).

NOTE: For those that don't qualify for the match play of Day 3 and 4, there will be a stableford competition available following the match play times. A time sheet will be available at Score Card Return following the match play draws being published.

Registration

Please ensure you arrive at least 30 minutes prior to your tee time each day to register. Registration will be in the club house. Following this, report to the starter at least 15 minutes prior to your tee time. Your score card and local rules will be given to you on the tee.

Score Cards and Return

On completion of your round, please return your scorecard to the designated 'scorecard return area' in the clubhouse. Live scoring will be displayed in the clubhouse, as well as being available online at www.golfnsw.org.

Championship Dinner

There will be a Championship Dinner held at Mudgee Golf Club on Sunday 19 March at 6.30pm for 7pm. This dinner is complimentary for all Championship participants. If you aren't able to attend, please notify Golf NSW as soon as possible. Additional guests are welcome at a cost of \$40 per head.

Food and Beverages

Coffee and toasted sandwiches will be available to purchase prior to the round each day and a lunch menu will be available to purchase from after the round.

Dress Regulations

All entrants must comply with the host Club and Golf NSW Standard Dress Regulations. Failure to do so will result in the player not being permitted to commence their round.

Withdrawal

If you are unable to participate, please notify us immediately. On presentation of a medical certificate a full refund will be issued, less an administration fee.

Motorised Carts

As per the conditions of entry for the Women's Summer Foursomes, participants must walk at all times during a stipulated round unless permission has been granted by the Committee. Applications for permission MUST be made at the time of entry. Golf NSW takes no responsibility for the availability of golf carts.
