Daily trophies for rounds 1 and 2 will be presented during the optional Gourmet Buffet Dinner on Wednesday 5 April. Overall and round 3 trophies will be presented immediately after the conclusion of the final round on Thursday 6 April. It would be appreciated if as many competitors as possible remain for the presentation to honour the respective trophy winners.

Please note: Championship Procedure

A total of 100 players will qualify to compete in the final round on the Ocean Course. The field will comprise:-

- (i) the 75 players (plus ties) with the lowest stroke scores;*
- (ii) the remaining places will be made up of players with the lowest nett scores not having qualified as per (i) above.*

All remaining players not qualifying as above will be allocated to the Moonah course for the third round.

Ties

In the event of a tie for the 54-Hole gross title, a hole by hole sudden death play-off will be conducted commencing on hole 1 of the Ocean Course followed by hole 18 of the Ocean Course continuously until a winner is determined. In the event of a tie for the 54-hole nett title, the count back method recommended by Golf Australia will be used.

Final Round Draw

A seeded draw will be created for the final round based on 36-hole gross totals. This will comprise of players in the leading 75 (plus ties) gross scores, with the remaining places (to a total of 100 players) being made up of players with the lowest nett scores not already included, this field will contest the final round over the Ocean Course via a multi-tee start commencing at 8:00am. The remaining balance of the field will compete over the Moonah Course at 8:00am via a multi-tee start.

Final round draws will be emailed and made available on the Golf Victoria Website at www.golfvic.org.au from 8:30pm on Wednesday 5 April. Golf Victoria reserves the right to modify the draw.

All players must be available at their allocated tee time as determined by Golf Victoria. Competitors unable to compete at the designated time forfeit the right to compete in the event.

Lunches

Lunch packs will be provided to all players each round and will be distributed from the registration/score card return area. Post-round food will be available for purchase at the bar.

Optional Gourmet Buffet Dinner– Wednesday 5 April

All players and guests are invited to attend the Optional Gourmet Buffet Dinner after the second round on Wednesday 5 April at a cost of \$40 per person.

The dinner will commence at approximately 6:30pm for a 7:00pm start. For catering purposes it is **essential** that all guests have pre-booked their dinner. The list of players and guests who have made a booking for the optional dinner as at the close of entries is attached below on page eight.

Players and guests that wish to attend and have **not** yet booked for the dinner must contact The National GC on (03) 5988 2734 or via email: DianaM@nationalgolf.com.au as soon as possible. **Bookings will not be accepted by the club on the day.**

Note: Neat & smart casual attire is required. No denim is allowed.

Practice Rounds

Practice rounds will be available for players upon payment of a \$50 green fee.

Available tee times are as follows:

Sunday 2 April: After 1pm (Old & Ocean courses)

Monday 3 April: After 12pm (Moonah & Old)

Bookings must be made through The National Pro Shop on (03) 5988 6777. Please note that tee times are strictly limited to the above mentioned and are subject to tee time availability.

Handicaps

Players are reminded that their GA Handicap as at Tuesday 4 April (Round 1) will be applied for all three rounds of the championship. However, as per the current GA Handicap system, a player's daily handicap will differ according to the slope of each course.

Carts

It is **compulsory** that all competitors use a motorised cart during all three rounds of the Championship.

Please Note: Cart bookings are included as part of the entry fee; all bookings have been made on a shared basis between **PLAYERS ONLY** unless otherwise arranged with The National Golf Club. Carts will only be available to players not spectators. Privately owned motorised golf carts are not permitted at The National Golf Club.

Scratchings

Any player wishing to scratch prior to Thursday March 30 2017 must ring GV tournaments on 03 8545 6218. To withdraw on the day of play please call the GV mobile (Glenn) on **0402 082 814**.

Caddies & Spectators

Spectators and caddies are permitted, subject to obtaining prior approval from the committee, and must strictly adhere to the etiquette and Rules of Golf at all times. Please note carts are supplied for players use only without exception.

Registration

All competitors are required to report to Golf Victoria representatives inside the clubhouse at the respective clubs upon arrival at the course. Players must then be present on the appropriate tee **no later than 10 minutes prior the tee time**.

Handicaps

All players must ensure that their current and correct daily handicap is recorded on the scorecard in accordance with Rule 6-2b. Players must play from their **DAILY** handicap during the Championship, with the exception that no player shall play from a GA handicap greater than the maximum limit of 18.0

Scorecards

All score cards are to be returned to the registration area situated in the clubhouse immediately at the conclusion of play.

Dress Regulations

All **players and caddies** are required to adhere to the Club's dress regulations with particular reference to the following: -

- ❖ Clean dress shoes **MUST** be worn in the clubhouse at all times. Athletic jogger shoes are not permitted.
- ❖ Advertising or display materials must not appear on clothing except for brand name logos.
- ❖ All shirts must have a collar.
- ❖ Tailored shorts are permitted.
- ❖ Denim clothing of any description is not permitted.

Any player not adhering to the Host Clubs' dress code will be prohibited from playing. Any caddie or guest not adhering to the Host Clubs' dress regulations will be requested to leave the course.

Course Care / Club Regulations

Players are reminded that sand buckets **MUST** be taken and used, pitch marks are to be repaired, and bunkers raked following play at each course. Mobile phones are not to be used in the clubhouse or on the course unless in the case of an emergency or a ruling during the round. Play will be from the nominated tee markers. Any player not complying with these requirements will be subject to action in accordance with the GV Code of Conduct.

Slow Play

Rule 6-7 will be strictly enforced. Each group must maintain its position on the course with respect to the group preceding them. Any group with a clear hole in front of them will be considered out of position. Penalties will be issued to individuals in such groups who by their pace contribute to such delay. Warnings may not be issued prior to penalties.

Suspension of Play

In the event of heavy rain, lightning or for any other reason, the Championship Committee will be responsible for deciding whether to suspend play. The signal for suspending play will be one short siren blast. The procedure when play is suspended is outlined under Rule 6-8b. When the course is ready for play, players will be advised to return to various locations. The signal for the resumption of play will be one long siren blast.

Refunds

Any entrant may withdraw and have the entrance fee refunded provided notification is received within three working days prior to the event (**5pm – Thursday 30 March**). Under no circumstances will entry fees be refunded after this date unless players can provide Golf Victoria supporting documents regarding their withdrawal from the event (ie. Medical certificate).

Safe thru 18' – First Aid Information Guide for Golfers

Golf Victoria is aware that occasionally situations arise out on golf courses where first aid or emergency action is needed, and often golfers are unsure of the best way to respond.
