- EVENT 1 (a) Queensland Men's Country Championship 36 Holes A Grade GA Handicap range 8.4 and under.
- EVENT 1 (b) Queensland Men's Country Championship 36 Holes B Grade GA Handicap range 8.5 14.4
- EVENT 1 (c) Queensland Men's Country Championship 36 Holes C Grade Handicap range 14.5 19.4
- EVENT 1 (d) Queensland Men's Country Championship 36 Holes D Grade Handicap range 19.5 36.4

2017 QUEENSLAND MEN'S COUNTRY GOLF WEEK CONDITIONS OF COMPETITION

1 FNTRIFS:

- 1.1 The Week is open to all male amateur golfers with a Golf Australia Men's Handicap who are members of a Club affiliated with a Queensland Country District and Golf Queensland. Members of clubs affiliated with the Brisbane District Golf Association are not eligible. Where a player is a member of both a club affiliated with a Queensland Country District and a Brisbane district, their home club <u>must</u> be that which is affiliated with the Queensland Country District.
- **1.2** Entry is via online registration only. Entries close on Wednesday 2nd August 2017 at 5:00pm. Players can check the Golf Queensland website for a list of entries received.
- **1.3** The entry fee must be paid when registering online.
- 1.4 Nominations are accepted at face value, on the basis that information contained therein is correct, and up to date. Should this subsequently be proven not to be the case, GQ reserves the right to deem any competitor ineligible at any time prior to or during the Championship.
- 1.5 Once the draw is published there will be no refund of entry fees to players who withdraw from the event. Players who withdraw prior to the draw being published will be refunded their entry fee, less an administration fee of \$11.00.
- 2. CHAMPIONSHIP COMMITTEE: A Championship Committee, appointed by Golf Queensland, shall have sole management and control of the event. The Championship Committee reserves the right to: (a) fix and/or alter starting times, (b) in the event of bad weather, or for any other reason, either shorten the contest or fix another date/venue, (c) vary any condition should they deem it advisable, (d) reject any entry without assigning any reason therefore. The decisions of the Championship Committee will be final in all matters and in the absence of a full committee, such members as may be present at the time may give a decision, and any such decision shall be deemed to be a decision of the full Championship Committee.
- 3. PUBLICITY: GQ arranges publicity before, during and/or after this Championship. It is a condition of entry that all players assent to references to them, and pictures of them in practice and play being published via any medium (including the internet).
- 4. PRIVACY: GQ may retain the personal details (i.e. name, address, handicap) of entrants in this Championship on its records. The purpose of doing so is such that information on other future events conducted by GQ (or other parties) can be forwarded as deemed appropriate by GQ. This information will not be available to any other organisation. Any person may have their details removed from this database by phoning GQ on 3252 8155
- 5. DRESS REGULATIONS: It is a requirement of this tournament that all players must comply with the dress regulations of the host club.
- 6. PRACTICE: The provision of practice rounds will be by arrangement with the host clubs, under whatever terms and conditions they determine.
- 7. HANDICAP: Players will play on their handicap as of this 14th August for the entirety of the week's events.
- 8. RULES: The Rules of Golf as adopted by the R&A Rules Limited will apply together with such Local Rules as are approved by the Championship Committee. In addition Distance Measuring Devices will be permitted at all events, by way of a local rule.
- 9. COURSE MARKERS: During practice or during the Championship a player shall not place on the course, or cause to be placed on the course, any artificial marker or other device designed to indicate course measurements. A player in breach of this condition shall be disqualified.
- 10. DRAWS AND STARTING TIMES: A draw for each day's play will be published. Players shall start at the time and in the order arranged by the Championship Committee. Rule 6-3a provides "The player shall start at the time laid down by the Committee". The penalty for breach of Rule 6-3a is disqualification. However it is a condition of this Championship that, in the absence of circumstances which warrant waiving the penalty of disqualification as provided in Rule 35-7, if the player arrives at his starting point, ready to play, within five minutes of his starting time, the penalty for failing to start on time is two strokes at the first hole, instead of disqualification.
- 11. BALL: It will be obligatory for all competitors in the Championship and in the qualifying round (if required) to play with a ball which is named in the current R&A and/or USGA Approved Lists. Copies of these lists are available from www.randa.org. Penalty: Disqualification.
- 12. TRANSPORTATION: Motorised transport is permitted.
- 13. TIES: In the event of a tie for the Queensland Men's Country Championship, unless the Championship Committee otherwise determines, play shall continue over such holes as the Championship Committee shall decide, players being eliminated hole by hole as they fail to maintain equality with other or others until the winner is determined. All other trophies will be decided by the Australian Countback System.
- 14. PROTESTS: Protests must be lodged in writing with the Championship Committee no later than 5 minutes after the conclusion of the player's round on each day.
- 15. **TEAMS EVENT:** A four (4) man nett teams event will be played in conjunction with the 36 hole Stroke Championship and will be decided by the aggregate of the scores of the best 3 players of the 4 on each day of competition. In the event of a tie for this event the 4th score will be included for those teams in a tie situation. Teams must consist of 4 players from the one club or 4 players from various clubs within the one District Golf Association. A player can be nominated in one team only.
- 16. CODE OF CONDUCT: All entrants are bound by Golf Australia's Code of Conduct ("the Code"). A copy of the Code is available at www.golf.org.au.

 Any breach of the Code may be recorded on the Central Register of the Code ("the Register"). The Register may be accessed (and published from time to time) by any State Association or Golf Australia for the purposes of administering Competitions or state championships, events, competitions, practice sessions or major activities conducted or sanctioned by a State Association, or any State Association or Golf Australia codes of conduct and/or other related matters.
- 17. TROPHIES: A Competitor shall not be eligible to win more than one trophy on any one day. Trophies will be presented at the host Club after close of play.
