Team Events

Dorothy McCook Salver:

A closed event: Club Team of 3 players from Division 1 and/or 2 with the best aggregate nett score on the first day of the Championship

Halcyon Cup:

A closed event, Club Team consisting of 3 players from Division 1 and/or 2 with the best aggregate nett score on the second day of the Championship

Barbara Smith Salver:

A closed event: Club Team of 2 players from Division 3 with the best aggregate 18 hole Stableford score on either day of the Championship.

36 Hole Gross Team Event.

An Open Event: A team of 2 – 3 players from any Club or Association with the best 36 hole gross aggregate of 2 players. In the event of a tie, the third player's score will determine the winning team. Further ties decided by the Golf Australia countback method

**Team names must be received before play on Day 1
(Monday 28th) of the Tournament.**

They may be handed in at Registration.

NHDLGA ANNUAL TOURNAMENT CONDITIONS OF PLAY

To be read in conjunction with NHDLGA Standard Conditions of Play and Golf NSW Code of Conduct.

1. Event Procedure

- 1.1 The events are open to all amateur women golfers who are members of clubs affiliated with Golf Australia and hold an official Golf Australia handicap.
- 1.2 The winner of the NHDLGA Open Event will be the player with the best gross score over 36 holes. In the event of the tournament being reduced to one day of 18 holes the best gross score for 18 holes will be declared the winner.
- 1.3 Divisions will be determined by number of entries received.
- 1.4 Handicaps will not vary during the 36 Hole tournament.
- 1.5 Entrants eligible for the Beryl Tobin Trophy must have a GA handicap of 16.0 or less and belong to a NHDLGA affiliated club.

2. Rules of Play

- 2.1 As adopted by R & A Limited and the Local Rules of the host clubs.
- 2.2 The tournament Match Committee is the Match Committee of the NHDLGA or its appointees.
- 2.3 The Committee reserves the right to refuse entry and settle all disputes.

3. Entry

- 3.1 In the event of entry applications exceeding the number of places available, precedence will be given in order of receipt of entry.
- 3.2 All players must enter on their Golf Australia handicap and play off the Daily Handicap applicable to the host club. Players must provide proof of handicap.
- 3.3 Clubs are restricted to only one team in each of the team events.

4. Ties

- 4.1 In the event of a tie for the winner of the NHDLGA Open Tournament a sudden death playoff on holes determined by the Match Committee will be conducted.
- 4.2 Ties in all other divisions and events will be decided by the Golf Australia recommended countback method.
- 4.3 Ties in team events will be decided by the GA recommended countback method if applicable.

5. Trophies

- 5.1 Players are eligible to win only one 36 Hole trophy with the exception of the Open and Closed Trophies. The Closed Trophy is open only to players from clubs affiliated with NHDLGA.
- 5.2 Perpetual Trophies will be awarded at the discretion of the Committee.

6. Registration

- 6.1 Players must register 30 minutes before their starting time and be ready to play 10 minutes before their tee time.

7. Database of Entrants Details – Golf NSW

The personal data contained in an entry is permanently retained by Golf NSW. This data may be utilised by Golf NSW or its sponsors for the distribution of correspondence, in both electronic and hard copy means. From time to time players may be sent Entry Forms, event literature, the Golf NSW e-newsletter, or marketing material by the sponsor(s) of Golf NSW events, or information about events conducted by Golf NSW-approved bodies. Upon receipt by Golf NSW of a written request, a player may either have access to their details, or have their details deleted from the database.
