CONDITIONS OF PLAY

1. The Glenelg Senior Amateur will be played as a Stroke play over 18 holes.
2. All players must have an official Golf Australia handicap. Eligibility: open to male amateurs aged 55 years or older on 21st August 2017 with a Golf Australia handicap of 24.4 or less at the time of entry. Players entering the Super Seniors event must be aged 65 years or older.
3. Play will be from the White tees.
4. The field will be strictly limited. In the event of entries exceeding this limit, a handicap ballot will apply.
5. In the event of a tie for placings, a countback will apply.
6. The use of a motorised cart is permitted however preference will be given to players who have a medical Certificate. A person may not bring on to the course any personal motorised transport.
7. Competitors must start at the appointed time. Rule 6-3 will apply.
8. The Match Committee of Glenelg Golf Club will make playing arrangements and be umpire in the case of a dispute or protest which must be lodged in writing with the Match Committee at the Clubhouse not later than 5 minutes after the conclusion of the day's play.
9. Competitors must play with a ball that is named in the current R & A and/or U.S.G.A. approved lists.
10. Players and caddies are expected to observe the dress standards and any course requirements of Glenelg Golf Club.
11. A presentation will be held immediately after all the results are posted. Players are not Permitted to win more than one major prize.
