\*In the event that two or more players are on the same number of matches won in their pool after round three;

> Final positions will be determined based on aggregate of holes won/lost during the three round robin matches played, and if two players are still tied then their individual match result will determine their position. If still tied then their seeding at the beginning of the Championship will determine final pool positions.

> If three players are tied after matches won and aggregate holes won, then their seeding at the beginning of the Championship will determine final pool positions.
