Finger food and drinks will be provided which is included in your entry fee.

Registration:

Competitors are required to register between 10:30 am and 1:30 pm on Sunday 18 June at Coolangatta & Tweed Heads Golf Club, in the river view terrace room located on the first floor. At this time, competitors will be required to provide a phone number where they can be contacted during the event. Failure to register may result in disqualification from the Championship.

If it is not possible to register in person, competitors must contact Cameron Vincent on registration day – 0448 742 132.

Withdrawals:

Please contact Golf Australia immediately on 03 9626 5000 if you are unable to compete. As per condition 10, once a player has been eliminated from the main championship, they are not permitted to withdraw from subsequent rounds unless on the receipt of a medical certificate, or in exceptional circumstances (as determined by the Championship Play Committee). Any player withdrawing from the Championship for a non-approved reason may have their entry into the 2018 Australian Men's Senior Amateur Championship declined.

Results & Draws:

All results and draws will be posted at www.golf.org.au. The final draw for round 1 will be available following registration on Sunday 18 June.

Practice Round:

ONE complimentary practice round is available for players from 12.30 pm on Sunday 18 June. Players **MUST** make a booking with the pro shop on 07 5524 4644. Play must be from the daily tee markers only – one ball only. (Competitors in breach of these practice conditions are liable to face action under Golf Australia's Code of Conduct.)

Additional practice round times, or times outside of the above may be available at the club's discretion.

Motorised Carts:

The cost of a shared golf cart for all Championship Rounds is included in the entry fee and these have been reserved. A cart for the practice round is **NOT** included. Players must book a cart via the pro shop on 07 5524 4644 if this is required for the practice round.

Players who would prefer their own motorized cart **MUST** advise this when entering the event and an additional charge of \$75.00 will apply. Every effort will be made to ensure all carts requests are accommodated.

Caddies:

Caddies will not be supplied. If players require a caddie they must make their own arrangements.

Dress Requirements:

"Hard/Metal" spikes are not permitted. Players, caddies and spectators must adhere to dress which is neat, tidy and appropriate to the game. Denim jeans/shirts, track or leisure pants, and clothing, hats, caps, and visors with excessive slogans or advertising are not permitted.

Distance Measuring Devices/GPS:

Distance measuring devices are permitted for this Championship.

Mobile Phones:

Players must have mobile phones turned off at all times whilst on the golf course during competition play except if being used solely as a Distance Measuring Device or to ring a Tournament Official for a ruling.

Golf Australia Hard Card:

The Golf Australia Hard Card will be in effect throughout the Championship and will be provided to players at registration.

Smoking:

Players are not permitted to smoke cigarettes, cigars or the like during a stipulated round. A competitor failing to adhere to this regulation will be in breach of Golf Australia's Code of Conduct.

Course Care:

All clubs which host Golf Australia National Championships kindly give up their course to you for the duration of the event. Hence, so that the course is left in a suitable condition once the Championship is completed, players **MUST** carry AND use a sand bucket and repair divots. Any player seen to be in breach of this request may face action under Golf Australia's Code of Conduct.
