***Amended Conditions of Play**

- 1. Entry Fees to be paid by the Individual Players, previously paid for by Club or District Association**
- 2. Multiple Team entries from the same Club or District Association now accepted**

Standard Conditions

3. Open to Clubs affiliated with Golf SA, Reciprocal Clubs & Invited Clubs
4. Entry must be made by the Individual or Team through www.mitournament.com
5. Entry fee to be paid online through MiTournament.
6. A District Association may enter one or more composite teams under the title of that District Association. The District Association Committee to select the team/s of the three (3) players, plus emergency from any of their affiliated Clubs within that District. Players may not be selected from Clubs that have entered for this event.
7. A team to consist of three players and an emergency, with Golf Australia handicaps not exceeding 23.9 and are "home" club players.
8. An emergency may substitute for a player up to the player's allotted starting time.
9. The Women's Sub-Committee of the Glenelg Golf Club Inc will arrange the event and reserves the right to alter any conditions, alter time of play and umpire any dispute or protest.
10. The Women's Sub-Committee will draw team members as it may deem desirable and players must start at their appointed time.
11. The Rules of Golf, the local rules of Glenelg Golf Club Inc and the Rules of Golf SA shall be the rules of play.
12. In the event of a tied Team result, there will be a countback of the aggregate score of the team, over the last 9, 6 & 3 holes. If there is still a tie, then hole by hole from the 18th.
13. The Team with the lowest total of the three gross scores for eighteen (18) holes will be the winner of the Silver Championship. The team with the highest total of the three stableford scores for eighteen (18) holes will be the winner of the Bronze Championship. Each team may only take one trophy.
