ENTRY FEE: \$30.00 PER PLAYER + QSOOM \$5 (includes drink and snacks at presentation)

CONDITIONS OF PLAY

1. Entries close Friday, 15th September 2017 and must be lodged at the Bribie Island Golf Club Ltd. by 5pm on that date. Entry Fee must accompany Entry Form.
2. The Rules of Golf adopted by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club, and local rules of the Bribie Island Golf Club shall be the Rules of Play for this event.
3. The Bribie Island Ladies Classic will be played over 36 holes with a Perpetual Trophy for the 36 Hole Winner (Gross) & trophies for Gross runner up, Net winners & runners up with daily trophies for best Gross and Net. Three divisions will be calculated according to the field handicaps.
4. Only one major trophy can be won by a player.
5. Players retain the same handicap for net aggregate events, but any alteration during the Classic is applicable to the daily net event in the following round.
6. Net Event prizes will be determined using the players Daily Handicap (Bribie Island Golf Club **Red** Course Rating 127).
7. **GA Handicap must not exceed 26.2 (Daily Handicap 29)**. Entrants whose handicap increases beyond 29 after the closing date are eligible for the Classic but will play off the handicap limit of 29.
8. The Field will be limited to 104 players.
9. Rule 6-7 will be strictly enforced. Each group must maintain its position in the field. Any group with a clear hole in front of it will be considered out of position; penalties may be issued to the individual/s in the group who, by their pace, are deemed to be contributing to the delay.
10. Professional golfers are permitted to caddy.
11. The players must report to the Starter at least **15 minutes** before the appointed start time. A player in breach of this condition may be disqualified.
12. Players must produce current evidence of Club Handicap signed by their Club Secretary or provide their current Golf link Number.
13. Dress regulations apply. Soft spikes only
14. Distance (only) Measuring Devices may be used – players are advised NOT to use applications that also provide, inter alia, temperatures, wind speed, forecasts etc. Use of such devices, whether the application is used or not, will entail disqualification.
15. Mobile phones taken onto the course **MUST** be switched off or placed in Silent Mode. Disqualification under Rule 33-7 may be applied.
16. Motorised buggies are not permitted in any gross event with the exception in the case of the presentation of a medical certificate or the player's age is 65+ at the time of entry, (proof of age may be required on request). Motorised carts must be booked through the Pro Shop 3408 2484.
17. NO refunds will be given after the closing date - exception Condition 7. Draw will be available in Calendar of Events on www.scbdwg.com.au &/or www.bribiegolf.com.au.
18. The Classic Committee reserves the right to alter or vary the conditions of play should they deem it necessary. Please check the notice board before play.
19. In the event of a tie in any competition, standard Golf Australia count back conditions will apply.
20. The Classic Committee will settle any dispute or protest which must be lodged, in writing, with the Classic Committee no later than 15 minutes after the end of the player's round on the day.
