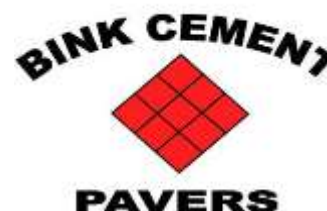

Note 3: If places are available, single day players will be accepted – on payment of half the relevant total entry fee.

Conditions of Play

1. The controlling Committee is the men's Golf Match Committee of Yowani Country Club and the Committee will have the power to vary the Tournament conditions and to decide any dispute or question.
2. As a Golf NSW Vardon Trophy event, the following condition applies:

Database of Entrant's Details

The personal data contained in an entry is permanently retained by Golf NSW. This data may be utilised by Golf NSW or its sponsors for the distribution of correspondence, in both electronic and hard copy means. From time to time players may be sent Entry Forms, event literature, the Golf NSW e-newsletter, or marketing material by the sponsor(s) of Golf NSW events, or information about events conducted by Golf NSW-approved bodies. Upon receipt by Golf NSW of a written request, a player may either have access to their details, or have their details deleted from the database.

3. Play shall be in accordance with the Rules of Golf and the Local Rules of Yowani Country Club. Golf NSW standard 2017 **Pace of Play** conditions apply.
4. All competitors in the event must have a current GA Handicap. A maximum daily handicap limit of 36 applies for this event. First round handicaps will remain the same for determining Championship results. Daily prizes will be decided on adjusted handicaps.
5. Numbers are limited. If a ballot is required, priority will be given to Vardon-eligible players. A waiting list will be maintained for entry forms received after the limit is reached.
6. Yowani Cup grades: A: up to 11, B: 12-18, C:19-36
7. The draw will be available by 4pm Mon 4 September, and full conditions for the Hole-in-One prize, at www.yowani.com.au The draw will be emailed to players who provide an email address.
8. Carts may be used, subject to availability.

9. Each player is eligible to win only one day prize, plus one overall (two day) prize. Single day players will be eligible for day prizes only.
10. If, at the completion of 36 holes, a tie exists in the overall Open title, a sudden death playoff will be held from the 1st hole. To be eligible to win the overall Yowani Open, a player must make himself available to participate in the play off, if one is required. **All other events shall be decided by count back.**
