# A GRADE CHAMPIONSHIP SALVER MEETING 2017

## Conditions of Entry

1. Entries will only be accepted upon payment of entry fee.
2. Late entries will be accepted at the host club's discretion.
3. Refunds will be available until entries close.
4. After entries close refunds will only be made at the discretion of the Executive Committee of the Southern Golf Group - Women.
5. Lunch, the menu for which is at the discretion of the host club, is provided.
6. Club Champion must verify that her name has been entered before commencement of play on day of competition.

## Conditions of Play

1. This event is conducted under the auspices of Golf SA, the Southern Golf Group, and under the Rules of "The R&A Golf Club of St. Andrews" and the local rules of the host club.
2. The Executive Committee of the Southern Golf Group-women will be the arbiter of any disputes or matters arising from the event.
3. Only women members of Golf Clubs affiliated with the Southern Golf Group-Women are eligible to enter.
4. Players must have a Golf Australia handicap and be able to verify it if requested.
5. The GA Handicap limit for this event is **0.00 – 20.0**.
6. Any player whose handicap changes after her entry is accepted will be allowed to play in the same Zone Championship event entered, but not exceeding the GA handicap limit for the event.
7. The gross event cannot be won by any player not in the appropriate handicap event.
8. In the event of a tie in any gross event a "sudden death" play-off will take place starting at the first hole.
9. In the event of a tie in the nett event, the tie will be determined as follows:

Score on back 9 holes (10 – 18) use  $\frac{1}{2}$  handicap,  
If still tied, countback on final 6 holes, use  $\frac{1}{3}$  handicap,  
If still tied, countback on final 3 holes, use  $\frac{1}{6}$  handicap,  
If still tied, countback hole by hole from 18<sup>th</sup>.

10. A player may not win a gross and nett event.
11. A player may not win more than one trophy except for the Veteran event and Champion of Champions.
10. To promote participation in this event, motorized transport may be used without a medical certificate.
11. Devices – The use of a personal measuring device (this does not include applications for mobile phones) by a competitor or caddy is permitted under the following condition:

a. The device must measure DISTANCE ONLY; it must not measure other conditions such as wind speed or direction, the slope of the ground or the temperature.

12. Play may be in groups of four (4).
13. Players must report to the Starter at least 30 minutes before starting time. If the player arrives at her starting point, ready to play, within five minutes after her starting time in the absence of circumstances which warrant waiving the penalty of disqualification as provided in Rule 33-7, the penalty for failure to start on time is two strokes at the first hole. Penalty for lateness beyond five minutes is disqualification.
14. Trophies will be presented on the day of play.
15. In the event of cancellation of play trophies will not be awarded.
16. If 9 holes have been completed by the whole field, trophies will be awarded.
