CONDITIONS OF PLAY

- The Committee shall make all arrangements and have full power to alter or make any variations to the Conditions should it be deemed desirable. All disputes shall be settled by the Committee, whose decision shall be final. Any member of the Committee competing in the Event shall not render any Ruling or decision which may affect her own position.
- Open to women members of Golf Clubs affiliated with Golf Australia with a maximum handicap of 45. Current handicap to be used on the day of the event.
- Entries should be made by the nominated closing date by, phone, fax or email. Late entries may be accepted
- The Committee will compile the draw 1 day prior to the event. Any player withdrawing from the event after the draw has been compiled, except those with an illness or under extraordinary circumstances, is expected to pay the full entry fee.
- All ties in handicap events will be decided on a count back in the manner recommended by Golf Australia. In the event of a tie in the Championship, a sudden death playoff will occur.
- Players are only eligible to win one major trophy.
- Inclement Weather: The committee reserve the right to suspend play and resume from where play was discontinued, or cancel the round. If a player fails to discontinue play immediately on suspension of play by the committee, she will be disqualified.
- Veterans – If you are 60 or older, please put a big **V** on your card.
