Format

Play will be a 12pm shotgun start on Saturday at Grenfell CC and a 9.30am shotgun start on Sunday at Forbes GC.

Registration

Please ensure you arrive at least 30 minutes prior to your tee time each day to register. Registration will be in the respective clubhouses, and must be done each day prior to commencing play. Your score card and local rules will be given to you at registration.

Score card return and scoring

On completion of your round, please return your scorecard to the registration desk. Live scoring will be displayed in the clubhouse, as well as being available online at www.golfnsw.org.

Rules officials

There will be a roving rules official on course on each day of play. Please utilise them if you need to.

Saturday Lunch & Dinner

Lunch will be provided to all competitors free of charge on Saturday at Grenfell from 11am. After the conclusion of play on Saturday there will be an optional 2 course meal also at Grenfell CC at a cost of \$30 per person. If you would like to attend the dinner please place your order and pay at registration on Saturday.

Sunday Lunch

Lunch will be provided to all competitors free of charge on Sunday at the conclusion of play prior to presentation.

Use of motorized carts

As per the conditions of entry, players may only use a motorized cart if a medical certificate is provided. This must be submitted to the Golf NSW office prior to the tournament. Bookings and payment for carts are the responsibility of the player.

Presentation

Presentation of prizes will take place following lunch on Sunday. If you are able to remain for this, please do so.

Withdrawal

If you are unable to participate, please notify us immediately. On presentation of a medical certificate a full refund will be issued, less an administration fee.

Conditions for State Events and Code of Conduct

The Golf NSW Standard Conditions for State Events and Code of Conduct will apply in accordance with the Championship Entry Conditions. A copy of the Standard Conditions and Code of Conduct is available from the Golf NSW website at www.golfnsw.org.

Player and Caddy Responsibilities

All Players and Caddies must adhere to commonly accepted standards of golfing etiquette and sportsmanship. Care of the course is an important aspect of etiquette and particular attention should be paid to the following:

- Repair divots, carry and use a sand bucket
- Repair pitch marks

A breach may lead to disqualification under Rule 33-7 and/or to disciplinary proceedings under the Golf NSW Code of Conduct. A player is responsible for the actions of their caddy.
