Format: Individual Stableford competition over 9 holes.

The leading male and female from a metropolitan and country club (4 players total) will qualify to Play 9 at the 2017 Emirates Australian Open.

Prize includes; Entry into the 2017 Emirates Australian Open Play 9 National Final; return economy air travel to Sydney, two nights' accommodation (Fri & Sat nights), transfers and all meals in Sydney; a weekend pass for the 2017 Emirates Australian Open as guests of Golf Australia; attendance at the Play 9 presentation cocktail party and more.

Eligibility: Open to any member of a South Australian club affiliated with Golf Australia who holds a GA handicap and has played in a Golf SA sanctioned event in the previous 12 months (between 1 Sep 2016 - 31 Aug 2017). Players must state which event they have played at time of entry.

Field size: 120 players (metro: 30 male and 30 female / country: 30 male and 30 female)

Handicap Limit: 36.4 for men; 45.4 for women | **Age:** Players must be 18 years or over as at 4 Oct 2017
