IMPORTANT INFORMATION

FORMAT

Monday 4 and Tuesday 5 September

The singles event will be played in two divisions. Handicaps for the divisions will be:-

Division One - GA Handicap - 0 to 17.0

Division Two - GA Handicap – 17.1 to 23.5

Division Three - GA Handicap – 23.6 to 45.4

Thursday 7 September

Foursomes stroke

The foursomes event will be played in two divisions. Handicaps for the divisions will be:-

Division One – Combined GA Handicap - 0 to 42.5

Division Two – Combined GA Handicap – 42.6 to 90.8

Please note that you will play off your daily handicap on each day of play.

Note: GOLF NSW Match Committee reserves the right to combine single entries to constitute a pair.

REGISTRATION

Registration must be done each day prior to commencing play with Golf NSW (an administration area will be set up in the Clubhouse or outside the Proshop). Please ensure you arrive at least 30 minutes prior to your tee time to register.

SCORE CARD RETURN AND SCORING

On completion of your round, please return your scorecard to the designated administration area. Please ensure you have noted your daily handicap and have two signatures before submitting. Scores will be posted in the Clubhouse.

RULES OFFICIALS

There will be a roving rules official on course on each day of play. You will be given a handout on the tee outlining a phone number you can call should you require a rules official for a ruling.

USE OF MOTORISED CARTS

Cart bookings need to be made by the players through the proshop of each club. Please advise Nicole if you have booked a cart.

PRESENTATION

Trophy Presentation will be held Tuesday 5 September at Liverpool Golf Club from approximately 5.30pm. Presentation of prizes for the Foursomes will be on completion of the round on Thursday 7 September at Macquarie Links Golf Club.

PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded in the following order based on value, with a maximum of one prize each day to be awarded. Trophies will be limited to one 36-hole trophy per player for the tournament and one 18-hole trophy per player per day.

Division 1 and Division 2 – Singles Stroke Event (Monday 4 and Tuesday 5 September)

36-hole Tournament – Scratch winner, nett winner and nett runner up.

18-hole Daily Events - Nett winner and nett runner-up.

Division 3 – Singles Stableford Event (Monday 4 and Tuesday 5 September)

36-hole Tournament - Stableford winner, runner-up and third place.

18-hole Daily Events - Stableford winner and runner-up.

Division 1 and 2 – Foursomes (Thursday 7 September)

18-hole Tournament – Nett Winner & Runner Up, Scratch Winner & Runner Up

DRESS REGULATIONS

All entrants must comply with the host Club and Golf NSW Standard Dress Regulations. Failure to do so will result in the player not being permitted to commence their round.

WITHDRAWAL

DISTANCE MEASURING DEVICES

Distance Measuring devices may be used, with the specimen local rule on page 153 of the Rules of Golf 2017 in place.

CONDITIONS FOR STATE EVENTS AND CODE OF CONDUCT

PLAYER AND CADDY RESPONSIBILITIES

All Players and Caddies must adhere to commonly accepted standards of golfing etiquette and sportsmanship. Care of the course is an important aspect of etiquette and particular attention should be paid to the following:

- Repair divots, carry and use a sand bucket
- Repair pitch marks

A breach may lead to disqualification under Rule 33-7 and/or to disciplinary proceedings under the Golf NSW Code of Conduct. A player is responsible for the actions of their caddy.
