Conditions of Entry

1. Entries will be limited to 150 players.
2. Tee times will be allocated according to handicap (special requests will be considered but cannot be guaranteed).
3. Entry fee must be paid with the registration form (each entrant must fill in a separate form). Cheque made payable to McCracken Golf Club Inc. Refunds will be made for cancellations made before 5th October 2016. Refunds for cancellations after this date will be at the discretion of the McCracken Golf Club Committee.
4. The McCracken Cup will consist of two Stableford rounds with daily prizes, as well as overall tournament prizes to be awarded on an aggregate basis. Rounds will be played off the White Tee Blocks for Men and Red Tee Blocks for Women
5. Daily A, B & C grades will be conducted for men and A & B grades for women. Grade handicap limits will be adjusted before the event to ensure that there are approximately equal numbers of players in each grade. Players will remain in the initial grade for the duration of event.
6. Use of motorised carts and devices used for measuring distance only are allowed for this event.
7. Presentations will be Sunday 8th around 4-30pm after the final round.
