CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Entries

Entries are limited to 200 and all entries will be accepted in order of receipt. **Entries are only accepted with full payment for golf and social events.**

Each player must complete and lodge a separate entry form, ie your playing partners must enter separately). Entry Fees are not transferable to another player.

Where numbers are exceeded for any event, preference will be given to the earliest received full week entries. If the tournament is oversubscribed any entry not accepted will be notified after the closing date. Successful entrants will be notified of their starting times, by mail or email.

Refunds will be made for cancellations received by 30th October, 2017. Refunds for cancellations after this date will only be given upon the receipt of evidence of compassionate grounds and if allowed will be made after the completion of the Tournament.

Draw and playing partners

During the social events on Sunday through Tuesday, we encourage you to play with members and visitors to enjoy the round with new people. Please indicate your playing partner preferences on the entry form if you have a pre-arranged group.

During the Championship rounds the draw will place you in your relevant handicap group. However if you need to share a cart or have travel arrangements that require a similar playing time please indicate on the entry form.

Social events

The Meet & Greet, Melbourne Cup lunch and Presentation Dinner. Bookings are essential. Please make bookings for the on the entry form with your golf bookings. Guests are welcome to the social events with an additional charge. Please book guests on the entry form.

Carts

Players may use a cart in each event. Please contact the Pro Shop on 8555 3271 to book a cart (\$35 each day). Please indicate the use of the cart and if sharing the name of the playing partner on the entry form for each competition.

Rules and handicap

Play will be governed by the Rules of Golf and the South Lakes Golf Club Local Rules. Disputes shall be decided by the Tournament Match Committee and its decision shall be final.

Conditions of Play for each event are available from the Club website and will be posted in the Pro Shop and Club House during the tournament.

Only Players with Golf Australia handicaps may enter the Tournament. All Australian players should have a Golf Link Number; Overseas players must show an official handicap card from their national authority.

Handicap limits for all events are men 36 and women 45. Individual events (Stableford and Stroke) will be played in 3 Grades that will be decided after entries are finalised. Probable grades will be Men A 0-13, B 14-19, C 20-36, Women A 0-24, B 25-31, C 32-45. In the Championship event, women's C-grade will play a Stableford competition while all other grades will play a Stroke competition.

TIED RESULTS in all events shall be decided using the standard count back method.

PRACTICE is not permitted on the competition course between the playing of the two rounds for the 36 Hole Championship.

Tournament Match Committee (The Committee)

THE COMMITTEE has the right to refuse entry, alter any event, re-handicap any player and make any other alteration to the program it considers essential. In the 36 Hole Handicap events, the competitor's daily handicap for each event handicap will be used.

Trophies and prizes

A PLAYER may not win more than one trophy daily, except novelty events. Players who win the 36 Hole event may also win the 18 Hole Handicap on Thursday.

Order of Precedence for trophies in Championship events shall be Championship winner, Championship runner-up, Handicap winner, Handicap runner-up. There will be a Phil Hoffmann plate award to the South Lakes man and woman member achieving the lowest Nett score over the two days.

THE WEDNESDAY ONLY AND THURSDAY ONLY DAILY COMPETITIONS ARE NOT PART OF THE CHAMPIONSHIP ROUNDS.

Draw and tee times

ALL PLAYERS must report to the Starter at least 20 minutes before Tee off time.
