WOMEN'S VARDON TROPHY 2018

Open to Amateurs whose Australian Handicaps are GA 14.0 or less.
(Under the auspices of and subject to the control of Golf SA Inc)

Entries close at 5:00pm on Friday 19th January 2018

CONDITIONS

- The Vardon Trophy Competition comprises scheduled stroke events of at least 18 holes and is open to amateur female golfers who are members of clubs affiliated with Golf SA Inc with an Australian Handicap of GA 14.0 or less at the time of registration.
- A minimum of 16 of the total scheduled rounds must be played to be eligible to win the Vardon Trophy including:**
 - At least four (4) 18 hole Vardon events**
 - At least four (4) 36 hole Vardon Events, one of which must be a National Ranking Event (the National Ranking Events being the Golf SA Rene Erichsen Salver and SA Amateur Championship).**

If a player competes in 18 rounds the player's worst adjusted score will be deleted, 20 rounds and over, the player's two worst adjusted scores will be deleted.
- Players representing South Australia in Interstate Tournaments can deduct rounds for which they are consequently unavailable from the total, up to a maximum of six (6) rounds only. Players representing Australia will be allowed to deduct a further two (2) rounds from the total. Should an event(s) be abandoned or curtailed the total will be reduced by the number of rounds lost.
- Players must register via MiTournament before being eligible. A player has not officially registered until their name is listed in the Registered Participants section of the event registration page. **Players are responsible for their own entries to individual events listed.** Host clubs will provide entry forms and results for club vardons.
- A player starting in an event but failing to return her score card, or who is disqualified, will be recorded as having 88 for the round. Similarly a player who enters an event but fails to take her place in the field will have 88 as her result. The above may be waived if a satisfactory explanation is given.
- All scores will be adjusted to a Scratch Rating of 70.
- The use of a motorised buggy by a competitor or her caddy is prohibited. Motorised means an electric or motor driven vehicle which a player or caddy may sit or ride, whilst the appliance is in motion. Exceptions to this condition may be granted where a player suffers from a permanent disability that would preclude her from competing in the event without the use of a motorised vehicle. Details for such exemptions are available from the office. Penalty Stroke Play – 2 strokes for each hole at which any breach occurred – maximum penalty per round 4 strokes.
- It is obligatory for all competitors to play with a ball which is named in the current R&A/USGA approved lists.
- Drug Testing: All competitors are subject to drug testing by the ASDA for banned substances as laid down in the Golf Australia's Doping Policy. Any competitor infringing this policy or refusing to take a test may be disqualified.
- Dress Rules: Players and their caddies must comply with the dress requirements of the host clubs. Non-compliance could see the player/ caddy not allowed to start or asked to leave the course.
- These conditions may be varied if the Match Committee of Golf SA deem it warranted. The Match Committee of Golf SA reserves the right to exclude any player from the event without assigning any reason for so doing. The Golf SA Code of Conduct applies to all events.
- The winner shall be the player who has the lowest adjusted scoring average over the competition. Trophies First, Second, Third.

Women's Super6 Vardon

- The Women's Super6 Vardon competition comprises scheduled stroke events of at least 18 holes and is open to amateur female golfers who are members of clubs affiliated with Golf SA Inc with an Australian Handicap of **GA 14.0 or less** at the time of registration.
- Players must register for the Women's Vardon Trophy by the closing date of registrations to be eligible for the Women's Super6 Vardon.
- Players must play a minimum of **SIX** rounds to be eligible including;
 - Four 18 hole Vardon events of your choice
 - One 36 hole Vardon event of your choice
- If a player plays more than the minimum required rounds, the players four best 18 hole Vardon events and best 36 hole Vardon event will be counted.
- A placegetter (1st, 2nd or 3rd *subject to change) in the overall Women's Vardon Trophy is ineligible for the Super6 Vardon.
- A player who plays the required rounds to be eligible for the Women's Vardon Trophy but is not a placegetter (1st, 2nd or 3rd *subject to change) in the Women's Vardon Trophy is eligible for the Women's Super6 Vardon.
- Conditions 4 – 12 of the Women's Vardon Trophy applies.
