The Tournament

- The Monday Shoot-Out will be played over 18-holes of modified stableford on Monday 20 November, 2017. The Tuesday Shoot-Out will be played over 18-holes of modified stableford on Tuesday 21 November, 2017
- The number of points awarded on each hole is determined based on comparison of the number of strokes taken in relation to the player's nett par.

Championship Committee

- The Championship will be under the management and control of the Tasmania Golf Club Championship Committee. 2.1
- In the absence of the full Championship Committee such members thereof as may be present at any time may give a decision and any decision shall be deemed the decision of the full Championship Committee.
- The Championship Committee will have sole management and control of 2.3 the Championship, with full power at any time to alter or vary any one of the
- 2.4 The Championship Committee decision on matters affecting the Championship will be final.

Rules of Play

The Rules of Golf, as adopted by R&A Rules Limited, will apply together with Local Rules as drawn up by the Championship Committee.

- 4.1 The Tasmanian Amateur Shoot-Out (Modified Stableford) is open to male and female amateur golfers. Male players must have an official Golf Australia handicap of thirty six (36) or less. Female players must have an official Golf Australia handicap of forth five (45) or less. In the case of overseas amateurs they must have a handicap equivalent to a Golf Australia handicap as certified by his/her home club or National association.
- The exact handicap certified at the time of entry is the handicap to be used 4.2 in the case of a ballot. For all other purposes, the player's handicap at the commencement of the round will remain for the entirety of the event.
- The entrance fee in the Tasmanian Amateur Shoot-Out (Modified Stableford) is \$10.00 (Inc. GST).
- Entrance fee must be paid at the time of entry.
- Entries must be made on the attached entry form and must be 4.5 countersigned by the Secretary or club official of the entrant's club.
- Entries must be made with the Secretary, Tasmania Golf Club, PO Box 425 4.6 Sorell, 7172 (Tasman Highway, Barilla Bay) not later than 5.00pm on Friday 17 November, 2017. It is the sole responsibility of the entrant themselves to ensure that their entry is received prior to the closing time for entries.
- The maximum field size for the Tasmanian Amateur Shoot-Out (Modified Stableford) is 84. In the event of applications exceeding the number of places available, entries for higher handicap competitors will be decided by handicap ballot. Unsuccessful entrants will be informed without delay and given the opportunity to compete if withdrawals subsequently occur. Entrance fees will be refunded to entrants balloted out, who do not
- 4.8 Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Championship Committee.
- Acceptable payments methods are only as follows credit card (online 4.9 only), cheque (personal or bank), money order, cash (please note that Tasmania Golf Club will not accept responsibility for cash sent that is not received) or funds transfer. Cheques or money orders are to be made payable to Tasmania Golf Club.
- 4.10 Entrants must conform in all respects to the Rules of Amateur Status, as adopted by R&A Rules Limited.
- The decision of the Championship Committee as to acceptance or refusal of any entry will be final.

5.1 Ties in all events will be decided by count-back in accordance with the system approved by Golf Tasmania.

Conforming Golf Balls, Driver Heads and Time of Starting

The specimen conditions in the Rules of Golf are in effect as regards to Conforming Golf Balls, Driver Heads and Time of Starting.



Motorised Transport

During play, it is prohibited for a player to ride in or on a motorised vehicle unless specific written permission has been granted by the Championship Play Committee. (NB Subject to host club permission, a caddie may use motorised transport at any time.) Penalty: 2 strokes for each hole at which a breach occurred; maximum penalty per round – 4 strokes (unless permitted to ride by a member of the Championship Rules Committee).

Procedure when breach discovered: Use of any unauthorised form of transportation must be discontinued immediately upon discovery that a breach has occurred.

Note i: Permission will only be granted to entrants who can provide a Medical Certificate.

Note ii:

GT takes no responsibility for the availability of golf carts.

Permission will be granted on the basis that the following Note iii: requirements are adhered to. Players failing to adhere to these requirements are liable to have such permission revoked:

Players who drive at a pace which is clearly quicker than walking pace; and/or who drive to a point past their ball which is clearly unreasonable for a player who is not using motorised transport to reach, are in breach of these requirements.

In the event of a breach between the play of two holes, the penalty applies to the next hole. Use of an unauthorised form of transportation must be discontinued immediately upon discovery that a breach has occurred. Otherwise the player is

Pace of Play

Rule 6-7 will be strictly enforced. Each group must maintain it's position on the course with respect to the group preceding it. Any group with a clear hole in front of it will be considered out of position. Penalties will be issued to individuals in such groups who by their pace contribute to such delay. Warnings may not be issued prior to penalties.

Drug Testing

All competitors are subject to drug testing by the Australian Sports Anti-Doping Agency for banned substances as laid down in Golf Australia's Anti-Doping Policy. Any competitor infringing this policy, or refusing to take a test, will be disqualified and subject to any sanction(s) brought down by ASADA. 10. Database of Competitors' Details

The personal data contained in this entry is permanently retained by Tasmania Golf Club. This data may be utilised by Tasmania Golf Club or its sponsors for the distribution of correspondence, in both electronic and hard copy means. From time to time players may be sent entry forms, event literature or marketing material by the sponsor(s) of Tasmania Golf Club events, or information about events conducted by Tasmania Golf Club approved bodies. Upon receipt by Tasmania Golf Club of a written request, a player may either have access to their details, or have their details deleted from the database.

11. Distance-Measuring Devices

A player may obtain distance information by use of a distance-measuring device. If, during a stipulated round, a player uses a distance measuring device to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect his play (e.g. elevation changes, windspeed, etc), the player is in breach of Rule 14-3

12. Code of Conduct

All entrants assent to be bound by Golf Australia's Code of Conduct. A copy of the code is available at www.golfaustralia.org.au

Protests

The decision of the Championship Committee will be final in all matters relating to the tournament. Protests must be made to the Championship Committee not later than 15 minutes after the conclusion of the day's play.

14. Publicity

Tasmania Golf Club and the sponsors arrange publicity before and during the Championship in the press, by live and recorded radio, television broadcasting and by filming. The competitors assent to reference to them and pictures of them in practice and play being used for commercial purposes by Tasmania Golf Club Tasmania Golf Club reserves the right to any press, and the sponsors. broadcasting or television fees paid or payable for permission to broadcast, photograph or televise play.

- 15.2 During practice or during the Championship a player shall not place on the course, or cause to be placed on the course, any artificial marker or other device designed to indicate course measurements. A player in breach of this condition shall be disqualified.
