In 1974 the South Australian Golf Association introduced the Men's Vardon competition, with the winner being decided on averages calculated over a number of events.

Women's Golf South Australia, introduced its Vardon series in 1976 and was based on a points system.

The Junior Boys Vardon has been running since 1981.

The formation of Golf SA in 2008 has seen the Vardon revised and merged into a single competition based on the same conditions of play.

The Vardon is ranked as one of the most prestigious Amateur golf competitions in the State.
