**Available from 12pm, Wed 6 Dec\_**(payment via credit card). If not sold out prior, bookings will close at 12pm Wed 3 Jan 2018 and a notice will be sent to all registered players by 5pm Fri 5 Jan.

When registrations open, Golf SA will provide a link on the following event page on the Golf SA website. Please note, registration for this event and the next Open Days will be via <a href="https://www.mitournament.com">www.mitournament.com</a> which Golf SA uses for every other event it manages, as it allows Golf SA to have more control of the booking process.

### <u>Instructions for registering online via MiTournament</u>

Once you have clicked on the **REGISTRATION link** on the Golf SA website (available noon Wed 6 Dec) follow these steps to register on-line.

- Log In (using your username and password if you have an account) or 'Sign Up Now' if new.
- If you have 'Forgotton your Password or Username' click on that option and it will be emailed to you.
- Once you have logged in, search tournaments (this can be done easily by selecting Golf SA as the Tournament Organiser).
- Find the Open Day and Click on the **Register** button next to the selected Golf SA event and follow the steps.
- If you want to register other/s select 'Add Another Player' and enter their details. You can then select the same or different tee times as desired.
- Once you have confirmed and made payment, you are registered and your name will be listed
  in the REGISTERED PARTICIPANTS list at the bottom of the event's MiTournament page
- The person who made the booking will receice a 'Payment Confirmation and Tax Invoice'
  this will show the tee time booked and names of players registered.

#### **Conditions of Play / Event Details**

- 1 **Event Format:** Stableford Comp (2 divisions)
- 2 **Handicaps:** Maximum Handicap Limit Men's GA 27.0
- 3 **Ties:** will be decided by countback.
- 4 Rules of Play: The Rules of Golf, as adopted by R & A Rules Limited, will apply together with

Local Rules of the venue Club.

- 5 **Measuring Devices:** A player may obtain distance information by use of a distance-measuring device. If, during a stipulated round, a player uses a distance-measuring device to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect their play (e.g. elevation changes, wind speed etc.), the player is in breach of Rule 14-3.
- 6 Category: Men's Only Event
- 7 **Motorised Transport:** Please note Golf Carts are available for hire, however a medical certificate is required. For bookings please call RAGC Pro-Shop on 8356 8508. Please note Royal Adelaide is a course not designed for cart use, any player who hires a cart must use them as per the instructions on the cart.
- 8 Cancellations & Booking Enquiries: Any bookings cancelled before 12pm Wednesday 3 January 2018 will have their money refunded. Any cancellations after this time will forfeit their entry fee. Cancellations to be made by emailing admin@golfsa.com.au
- 9 **Pace of Play:** Players are requested to be mindful of their pace of play throughout their rounds. Remember your place in the field is 'behind the group in front', not 'in front of the group behind'.
- 10 **Dress Codes Regulations:** Players must observe host club dress regulations for Royal Adelaide Golf Club as the club has right of refusal for players not observing dress codes.
  - Consistent with the standards of the Club, smart attire is required at all times.
  - Shirts must have collars. Golf turtle neck shirts or skivvies are acceptable. Shirts must be tucked in unless the shirt is expressly tailored to hang loose in which case the shirt must be no longer than hip height.
  - Sockettes or ankle socks are to be substantially white or of a colour that matches the
    predominant colour of the golfer's outfit. Dress socks are to be plain white or white with a
    Club logo.
  - Shorts must be tailored and worn with a belt. Cargo shorts (i.e. shorts with patch pockets sewn onto the side) are not permitted.
  - Three quarter trousers, denim clothing, track tops and leisure suits are not permitted.
  - Logos on shirts are to be no larger than pocket size. Shirts with messages, cartoons, loud advertising slogans are not permitted.
  - All tattoos must be covered at all times on the Links and in the Clubhouse.
