Notes:

- (i) The field for the Traralgon Classic will be limited to 70 male players and 30 female players. Should a capacity field be reached, a **ballot by handicap** will occur at the close of entries.
- (ii) After 54-holes, the leading 54 men and 22 women (both inc. ties) shall qualify for the fourth round.
- (iii) GA handicap limit at close of entry: 9.0 Strokes (Men) and 15.0 Strokes (Women).
- (iv) **Entrance Fee \$120.00** (all entries online via the registration portal at www.golfvic.org.au) (incl. lunch all days and GST). Any balloted player will receive a full refund and will be processed after the closing date.
- (v) Entries open on Monday 18 December 2017 & close at 5.00pm on Tuesday 16 January 2018. Note: Entrant lists will be published on Wednesday 17 January 2018.
- (vi) The Traralgon Classic will be allocated to category (i) within the list of events/achievements under which respective men's and women's amateur exemptions to the 2018 Oates Vic Open starting field will be allocated. (See Condition 1.7)

2018 MEN'S & WOMEN'S TRARALGON CLASSIC - CONDITIONS

(To be read in conjunction with the Golf Victoria Standard Event Conditions as published on the GV Website at www.golfvic.org.au)

COMPETITION PROCEDURE

- The Traralgon Classic will be played over 72-holes stroke play consisting of 18 holes on Friday, 36 holes on Saturday and 18 holes on
- The field for the Traralgon Classic will consist of 70 male players and 30 female players.

Note: The Championship Committee reserves the right to increase the number of male or female players should the total field size not be achieved.

- After 54 holes, the top 54 male players, and 22 female players (both including ties) will continue.
- In the instance the number of entries exceeds the maximum field capacity, a ballot by handicap will occur at the close of entries. Unsuccessful entries will be informed without delay and given the opportunity to compete if subsequent withdrawals occur
- If a competitor alters their handicap during the Competition, their handicap as of the first day of play shall prevail throughout for all prizes. Players must play from their current handicap during the Championship, with the exception that no player shall play from a GA handicap greater than the maximum limit of 9.0 strokes (men) and 15.0 strokes (women).
- In the event of a tie for the Men's or Women's Traralgon Classic Champion, a play-off is to be staged if time permits, otherwise a countback will be utilised. The play-off will be played at a time and in a manner as decided by the Championship Committee. Ties for all other positions shall be decided by count-back as recommended by Golf Australia.

2018 OATES MEN'S & WOMEN'S VIC OPEN EXEMPTION

The Traralgon Classic will be allocated to category (i) within the list of events/achievements under which respective men's and women's amateur exemptions to the 2018 Oates Vic Open starting field will be allocated.

Amateur exemptions will be allocated in order as outlined on the 2018 Oates Vic Open entry form from category (a) onwards. Therefore, exemption into the starting field for category (i) is dependent on prior exemption categories being fully utilised.

ELIGIBILITY

- Eligible players are male amateurs whose GA Handicap or overseas equivalent at the close of entry does not exceed 9.0 strokes, and female amateurs whose GA Handicap or overseas equivalent at the close of entry does not exceed 15.0 strokes in accordance with the Australian Handicapping System.
- Entries will be restricted to amateurs, who are members of clubs 2.2 affiliated with Golf Victoria, or of golf clubs registered with such State or Overseas Associations as are affiliated with or recognised by this Association, or of clubs affiliated with the Victorian Golf League and Registered Golfers.

ENTRIES

- The entry fee is \$120.00 (inc. GST). Light lunch is included for all days. 3.1
- 3.2 All entries are to be submitted via the online registration portal at www.golfvic.org.au.
- Golf Victoria shall have the right to refuse the entry of any person 3.3 without being required to give any reason for such refusal.
- The draw for the competition will be sent to players and available at 3.4 www.golfvic.org.au approximately one week before the event.

TROPHIES

Trophies will be awarded for:

- Overall 72-Hole Gross Winner, Runner-Up & Third Place Overall 72-Hole Nett Winner & Runner-Up
- Best Gross & Nett (Each Round) Winner
- Daily NTP

WOMEN

- Overall 72-Hole Gross Winner & Runner-Up Overall 72-Hole Nett Winner & Runner-Up
- Best Daily Gross & Nett (Each Round) Winner
- Daily NTP

Players may win a maximum of 2 trophies (exc. NTP)

Trophies are subject to change dependent on final numbers.

CHAMPIONSHIP COMMITTEE

The Championship Committee shall consist of representatives of the Traralgon Golf Club and Golf Victoria. In the absence of the full Championship Committee, such members thereof as may be present at any time may give a decision and any decision shall be deemed the decision of the full Championship Committee. The Championship Committee reserves the right to vary any condition of this event.

In the event of bad weather, or for any other reason, the Championship Committee may shorten the competition, appoint another day or days for completion of, or may transfer play to another course. Protests must be made to the Championship Committee not later than 10 minutes after the conclusion of each round. The decision of the Championship Committee will be final in all matters relating to the Tournament.

6. **REFUND POLICY**

Any entrant may withdraw and have their entry fee refunded provided notification is received within three working days prior to the commencement of the event. Under no circumstances will entry fees be refunded after this date unless players can provide Golf Victoria supporting documents regarding their withdrawal from the event (ie. Medical Certificate).

7. MOTORISED TRANSPORT

According to GV's standard conditions of competitions, it is the responsibility of the player, if they require the use of a golf cart during the event to send a Medical Certificate and a completed copy of the Golf Victoria Motorised Transport Approval Return Form for consideration by the Match Committee. Please go to the GV website under Championships & Events → Event Resources → Motorised Transport for the return form and more information.

Exemption: Players aged 75 years and over do not require a Medical Certificate. Golf carts are at the player's own expense and MUST be booked directly with the respective golf club as soon as possible. Golf Victoria cannot guarantee the use of a golf cart on any given day of play as this is subject to each host club's conditions of usage.

Note: In the event in which a limited number of carts are available, players requesting carts will be paired together. Caddies are permitted to ride in the cart with the player ONLY when sufficient carts are available.

In certain circumstances, your information may be disclosed overseas, for example to the International Golf Federation.

The Golf Victoria Privacy Policy contains information about how you may access and request correction of your personal information held by Golf Victoria or make a complaint about the handling of your personal information, and provides information about how a complaint will be dealt with by Golf Victoria. Your relevant event entry may be rejected if the information is not provided.
