2018 GEOFF OGILVY & FUTURE CHAMPIONS TROPHIES – CONDITIONS

(To be read in conjunction with the Golf Victoria Standard Event Conditions as published on the GV Website at www.golfvic.org.au)

1. ELIGIBILITY

Geoff Ogilvy Trophy

- 1.1. Geoff Ogilvy Trophy: The competition is open to male junior amateurs who are members of a Victorian Golf Club, have a GA handicap of 20.4 or less at time of the specific event they are competing in and are under 18 years of age as at January 1st, 2018.
- 1.2. Under 16's Circuit: The competition is open to male junior amateurs who are members of clubs of a Victorian Golf Club, have a GA handicap of 20.4 or less at time of receipt of entry and are aged between 14 and 15 as at January 1st, 2018.
- 1.3. Under 14's Circuit: The competition is open to male junior amateurs who are members of clubs of a Victorian Golf Club, have a GA handicap of 20.4 or less at time of receipt of entry and are under 14 years of age as at January 1st, 2018.

2. ELIGIBILITY

Future Champions Trophy

- 2.1. Future Champions Trophy: The competition is open to female junior amateurs who are members of a Victorian Golf Club, have a GA handicap of 20.4 or less at time of the specific event they are competing in and are under 18 years of age as at January 1st, 2018.
- 2.2. Under 16's Circuit: The competition is open to female junior amateurs who are members of clubs of a Victorian Golf Club, have a GA handicap of 20.4 or less at time of receipt of entry and are aged between 14 and 15 as at January 1st, 2018.
- 2.3. Under 14's Circuit: The competition is open to female junior amateurs who are members of clubs of a Victorian Golf Club, have a GA handicap of 20.4 or less at time of receipt of entry and are under 14 years of age as at January 1st, 2018.

3. SCORING

- 3.1. To qualify for the Geoff Ogilvy or Future Champions Trophy, a minimum of 15 rounds must be played in events scheduled with Geoff Ogilvy or Future Champions status during 2018. The 15 rounds MUST include a minimum of:-
 - 1 x 72 hole event
 - 2 x 18/36 hole (Metropolitan) events at clubs affiliated with Golf Victoria
 - 2 x 18/36 hole (Country) events at clubs affiliated with Golf Victoria
- 3.2. To qualify for the Under 16 and Under 14 Trophy, a minimum of 10 rounds must be played in events scheduled with Geoff Ogilvy status during 2018.
- 3.3. Where an event is abandoned or curtailed, the number of rounds so lost will be deducted from the minimum required in the Geoff Ogilvy or Future Champions Trophy only, not the age categories.
- 3.4. Scores returned on a course with a daily scratch rating of more (or less) than 70 will be decreased (or increased) by the number of strokes by which the rating is more (or less) than 70.
- 3.5. A player who, having entered an event, fails to take his place in the field, fails to return his card or is disqualified, will be recorded with a score of 99 for that round or rounds, unless a satisfactory explanation is received.
- 3.6. For each round played above 15 rounds, the player's worst adjusted score or scores are deleted as follows:-
 - 16 rounds – 1 worst score deleted
 - 17 rounds – 2 worst scores deleted
 - 18 rounds – 3 worst scores deleted and so on.

4. ENTRIES

- 4.1. Event entries are subject to the specific event conditions
- 4.2. Golf Victoria reserves the right to accept or refuse any entry.
- 4.3. All entrants in the 2018 Geoff Ogilvy and Future Champions Trophy and their attending parents and caddies are required to adhere to Golf Victoria Code of Conduct in all GV, Geoff Ogilvy and Future Champions events.

5. WINNERS

- 5.1. The winners of the Geoff Ogilvy and Future Champions Trophy will be the player who has the lowest adjusted scoring average for the year. He and she will hold the title for one year and will be presented with a personal trophy. Both main trophies will be engraved and displayed at Golf Victoria. The runner-up and third place-getter shall also be presented with trophies.
- 5.2. Trophies will also be presented to the male and female players aged between 14 and 15 as at the 1st January, 2018 with the lowest adjusted scoring average for the year and the male and female players aged Under 14 as at the 1st January, 2018 with the lowest adjusted scoring average for the year.
- 5.3. In the event of a tie or ties, the winner shall be the player with the best average score over all his completed rounds.

PRIVACY
