







2018 Oates Vic Open Pro-Am

Wednesday 31 January 2018 - 13th Beach Golf Links

Thank you for participating in the **2018 Oates Vic Open Pro-Am.** The Pro-Am will commence via a shot-gun start at **7.45am** on both the Beach and Creek courses. To ensure your enjoyment of the day, please note the following: -

- Morning Food Availability: Complimentary pastries, fruit and tea/coffee will be available upon registration.
- Motorised Carts & Pull Buggies: A large number of groups on the Creek course and a smaller number of groups on the Beach course have been allocated specifically numbered motorised carts as indicated on the draws. Cart keys can be collected at the Golf Operations Shop.

The remainder of players will be required to utilise pull buggies. While some pull buggies will be available, given the large Pro-Am field size, players are encouraged wherever possible to bring their own pull buggie or carry bag. Players teeing off holes 6 to 17 of the Creek course are able to park in the car park adjacent to the 9th hole if desired.

- Pro-Am Competition & Scorecards: Team Aggregate Stableford format the best two individual stableford scores
 to count for each hole. Professional's scores can be used as part of the team score for each hole. All professionals
 to play from scratch while all amateurs to play from their respective handicaps. The professional in each group will
 be issued with the team score card at registration. One player in each group is to be responsible for completing the
 card with two signatures required before the card is submitted at the completion of the round.
- Handicap Stroke Hole Index: Male & Female amateurs are to use the respective hole index and hole par information as stated on the official Pro-Am scorecard for each respective course. Daily Handicap Look-Up Sheets for both the men's and women's courses will be available at registration to assist in determining Daily Handicaps.
- Tee Markers (both courses): Blue Oates Tees Male Professionals; Yellow Oates Tees Female Professionals & Male Amateurs; Red Tees Female Amateurs;
- **Finding Your Starting Hole:** Course Maps will be available at registration. In addition, club volunteers are also available to assist players locate their respective starting hole.

Note: For regular players at 13th Beach, please remember that the Beach course is played in a different hole order for the Oates Vic Open.

- On-Course Drinks: Complimentary Mt. Franklin water and Powerade courtesy of Coca-Cola Amatil will be available from drinks carts moving around each course during the round.
- **Pro-Am Prizes**: 1st, 2nd & 3rd for best performed teams on each course. Nearest the pin prizes will be awarded on the 17th Beach & 15th Creek while longest drive prizes will also be awarded for the 18th hole on each course for both men & women.
- Challenge Hole-in-One Competition: The Australian Beer Company and Coca-Cola Amatil will be putting up 20 cartons of Yenda Beer for any participant that makes a hole-in-one on either the 3rd hole on the Beach Course or the 12th hole on the Creek Course. There will be a small cash donation required to be eligible to win the prize with all proceeds going directly to Challenge supporting kids with cancer, the official Oates Vic Open charity for 2018.
- Suspension of Play: In the event of heavy rain, lightning or for any other reason, the Championship Committee will
 be responsible for deciding whether to suspend play. The signal for suspending play will be one short siren blast. The
 procedure when play is suspended is outlined under Rule 6-8b. When the course is ready for play, players will be
 advised to return to various locations. The signal for the resumption of play will be one long siren blast.
- **Scorecard Return**: All team scorecards are to be returned to the registration tables adjacent to the clubhouse bar entry doors.
- Oates Vic-Open Pro-Am Presentation Luncheon: Following the conclusion of play at approximately 12.45pm, the complimentary Pro-Am luncheon will commence in the clubhouse including the presentation of all prizes.
